



The Student Transcript is used to exchange a wide range of grade information. The schema can be used to exchange a complete academic record, select transcript information, report card grades for a grading period, or end-of-year report card or graduation associated with a student.

Field	Description
Submission	3 - Summer 4 - Extended
Interchanges	Interchanges are XML Schema Definitions (XSDs) which group related complex types. Select Student Transcript .
Effective Date	Only data as of this date reports. Default value is today's date.
Status	RegularResubmissionWorking Collection
Report Type	XML
Filter By	This field allows you to narrow the report results to specific Calendars, Calendar Years (District), or Schools.
Population	This option allows you to limit report results to Unique IDs. The Unique ID option only considers students with a Unique ID. The <i>All</i> option considers all students.
Ad Hoc Filter	Select an Ad Hoc filter to limit report results to those that meet filter requirements.
Report Generation	The report can be marked to generate immediately using the Generate Extract button or can be marked to generate at a later time using the Submit to Batch button. See the Batch Queue article for additional guidance.
