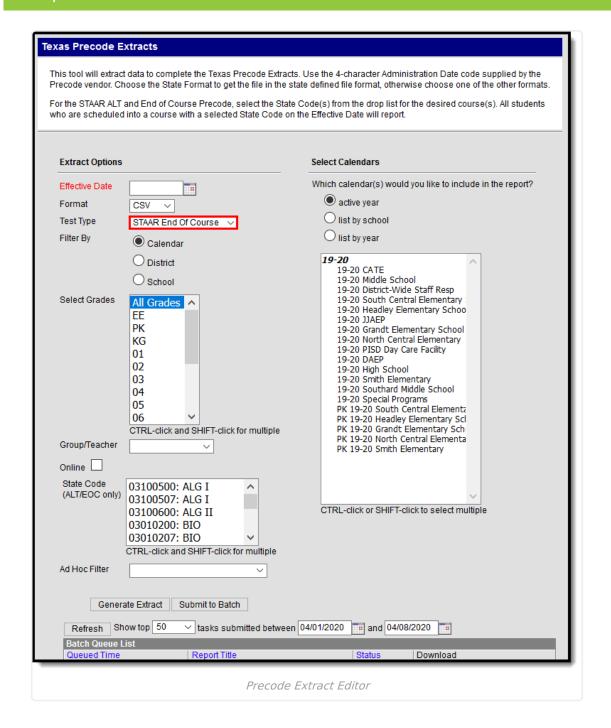

The purpose of the STAAR End of Course (EOC) assessments is to measure students' academic performance in core high school courses and to serve as part of the graduation requirements, as well as aid in measuring college readiness and the need for developmental coursework in higher education. Students first enrolled in grade 9 or below in the school year will be required to take the STAAR EOC assessments for courses in which they are enrolled as part of their graduation requirements and not the TAKS assessments.

STAAR EOC Assessments are available for Algebra I and II, Geometry, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, English I, II and III, World Geography, World History and U.S. History. The score a student achieves on each EOC assessment will be worth 15% of the student's final grade for that course.
