The following information describes vaccine compliance rules as defined by the Oklahoma State Department of Health.

General Compliance

- Vaccine doses administered less than or equal to 4 days before the minimum interval or age shall be counted as valid.
- Doses administered 5 days earlier than the minimum interval or age shall not be counted as valid doses and shall be repeated as age-appropriate.

4 doses PK Compliant	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student is in state grade: PK3F: Pre-Kindergarten Full-day 3-year-old, PK3H: Pre-Kindergarten Half-day 3-year-old, PK4F: Pre-Kindergarten Full-day, PK4H: Pre-Kindergarten Half-day, the student receives four doses of the DT, Td, Tdap, or DTaP combined vaccine, the difference between the second and previous dose is greater than or equal to 28 days with a 4 day tolerance, the difference between the third and previous dose is greater than or equal to 28 days with a 4 day tolerance, and the difference between the fourth and previous dose is greater than or equal to 6 months with a 4 day tolerance.
5 doses Compliant	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student is in state grade: KG: Kindergarten Full-day, KG/H: Kindergarten Half-day,01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, the student receives five doses of the DT, Td, Tdap, or DTaP combined vaccine, the difference between the second and previous dose is greater than or equal to 28 days with a 4 day tolerance, the difference between the third and previous dose is greater than or equal to 28 days with a 4 day tolerance, the difference between the fourth and previous dose is greater than or equal to 28 days with a 4 day tolerance, and the difference between the fifth and previous dose is greater than or equal to 6 months with a 4 day tolerance.
4 doses Compliant	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student is in state grade: KG: Kindergarten Full-day, KG/H: Kindergarten Half-day,01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, the student receives four doses of the DT, Td, Tdap, or DTaP combined vaccine, and the difference between the last dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 48 months with a 4 day tolerance, the difference between the second and previous dose is greater than or equal to 28 days with a 4 day tolerance, the difference between the third and previous dose is greater than or equal to 28 days with a 4 day tolerance, and the difference between the fourth and previous dose is greater than or equal to 6 months with a 4 day tolerance.



Rule	Requirements
7+ catch Up In Progress	 Students are considered in progress if the following conditions have been met: the student is at least 84 months old, the student receives three doses of the DT, DTap-DTP, Td, or Tdap vaccine, the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than or equal to 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, the difference between the second and previous dose is greater than or equal to 28 days with a 4 day tolerance, and the difference between the third and previous dose is greater than or equal to 6 months with a 4 day tolerance.

Hepatitis A



Rule	Requirements
2 doses Compliant	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student receives two doses of the Hepatitis A vaccine, the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, and the difference between the second and previous dose is greater than 6 months with a 4 day tolerance.

Hepatitis B



Rule	Requirements
3 doses Compliant	Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: • the student receives three doses of the Hepatitis B vaccine.
2 doses Compliant	 Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: the student receives two doses of the Hepatitis B vaccine, the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 132 months with a 4 day tolerance, and the difference between the second dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 6 months with a 4 day tolerance.

2 MMR Compliant	Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: • the student receives two doses of the MMR or MMRV vaccine, • the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, and • the difference between the second and previous dose is greater than 28 days with a 4 day tolerance.
2 M,M,R Compliant	Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: • the student receives two doses of the Measles vaccine, • the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, and • the difference between the second and previous dose is greater than 28 days with a 4 day tolerance, • the student receives two doses of the Mumps vaccine, • the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, and • the difference between the second and previous dose is greater than 28 days with a 4 day tolerance, • the student receives two doses of the Rubella vaccine, • the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, and • the difference between the second and previous dose is greater than 28 days with a 4 day tolerance.

1 M,M,R Compliant	Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade: PK3F: Pre-Kindergarten Full-day 3-year-old, PK3H: Pre-Kindergarten Half-day 3-year-old, PK4F: Pre-Kindergarten Full-day, PK4H: Pre-Kindergarten Half-day, • the student receives one dose of the Measles vaccine, and • the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, • the student receives one dose of the Mumps vaccine, and • the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, • the student receives one dose of the Rubella vaccine, and • the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance.
1 dose MMR In Progress In Process	Students are considered in process if the following conditions have been met: • the student receives one dose of the MMR or MMRV vaccine, and • the difference between the last dose and the effective date is less than 28 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.
1 dose M,M,R In Progress In Process	Students are considered in process if the following conditions have been met: • the student receives one dose of the Measles vaccine, and • the difference between the last dose and the effective date is less than 28 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance, • the student receives one dose of the Mumps vaccine, and • the difference between the last dose and the effective date is less than 28 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance, • the student receives one dose of the Rubella vaccine, and • the difference between the last dose and the effective date is less than 28 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.

Polio

Rule	Requirements
4 doses Compliant OPV End Date: 04/01/2016	Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: • the student receives four doses of the IPV, OPV, or IPV/OPV combined vaccine.



Rule	Requirements
3 doses Compliant OPV End Date: 04/01/2016	Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: • the student receives three doses of the IPV, OPV, or IPV/OPV combined vaccine, and • the difference between the last dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 48 months with a 4 day tolerance.
3 doses PK and younger Compliant OPV End Date: 04/01/2016	Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade: PK3F: Pre-Kindergarten Full-day 3-year-old, PK3H: Pre-Kindergarten Half-day 3-year-old, PK4F: Pre-Kindergarten Full-day, PK4H: Pre-Kindergarten Half-day, and • the student receives three doses of the IPV, OPV, or IPV/OPV combined vaccine.

Tdap

Rule	Requirements
8-12 2011 No Requirement Active End Date: 06/30/2012	Students in state grade: 08, 09, 10, 11, 12 are not required to receive any doses of the Tdap vaccine.
9-12 2012 No Requirement Active End Date: 06/30/2013	Students in state grade: 09, 10, 11, 12 are not required to receive any doses of the Tdap vaccine.
10-12 2013 No Requirement Active End Date: 06/30/2014	Students in state grade: 10, 11, 12 are not required to receive any doses of the Tdap vaccine.
No Requirement Active End Date: 06/30/2015	Students in state grade: 11, 12 are not required to receive any doses of the Tdap vaccine.
12 2015 No Requirement Active End Date: 06/30/2016	Students in state grade: 12 are not required to receive any doses of the Tdap vaccine.



Rule	Requirements
1 dose Compliant	Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade: 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, and • the student receives one dose of the Tdap vaccine.
Grades 7-12 Non-Compliant Active Start Date: 07/01/2011	Students in state grade: 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, with no doses of the Tdap vaccine are considered non-compliant.
