




The Prenatal tool tracks information about a person's Prenatal history and reports that information in the ISBE Prenatal Extract.





## Prenatal Fields Available in Ad hoc Query Wizard

Use the fields available in the **Student > Learner > Birth to 3** folder to create ad hoc reports. Select the Student Data Type from the Filter Designer options.



## **Prenatal Detail**

The following fields are available on the Prenatal editor.

Field	Description	Ad hoc Name
Prenatal Services Start Date Required	Indicates the start date of prenatal services.	prenatal.startDate
Prenatal ID	Provides an identification value for the prenatal record.	prenatal.prenatalID
Prenatal Services Exit Date	Indicates the end date of prenatal services.	prenatal.endDate



Field	Description	Ad hoc Name
Prenatal Services Exit Reason	Indicates why the prenatal services ended.  When the selected reason is 01: Live Birth, additional fields display in red (required).	prenatal.exitReason
Delivery Due Date	Indicates the individual's due date.	prenatal.deliveryDueDate
Actual Delivery Date	Indicates the date the baby was delivered.  This field is required when the Prenatal Services Exit Reason is 01: Live Birth.	prenatal.actualDeliveryDate
Prenatal Care Start Trimester	Indicates in what trimester the individual began receiving services.	prenatal.prenatalCare StartTrimester
Marital Status of Mother	Indicates whether the mother is married, not married, divorced, etc.	prenatal.motherMaritalStatus
Place of Delivery	Indicates where the baby was delivered (hospital, home, etc.).  This field is required when the Prenatal Services Exit Reason is 01: Live Birth.	prenatal.placeofDelivery
Town or City of Delivery	Indicates the town or city in which the baby was delivered.  This field is required when the Prenatal Services Exit Reason is 01: Live Birth.	prenatal.townOrCityOfDelivery
State of Delivery	Indicates the state (IL, etc.) in which the baby was delivered.  This field is required when the Prenatal Services Exit Reason is 01: Live Birth.	prenatal.stateOfDelivery
County of Delivery	Indicates the county in which the baby was delivered.  This field is required when the Prenatal Services Exit Reason is 01: Live Birth.	prenatal.countyOfDelivery
Number Home Visits in Year	Indicates the total number of home visits the mother and baby received during the year.	prenatal.numHomeVisits



Field	Description	Ad hoc Name
Number Parent Groups in Year	Indicates the total number of parent groups the mother (and baby) attendance during the year.	prenatal.numParentGroups
Number of Birthed Children	Indicates the total number of children the mother has birthed.  This field is required when the Prenatal Services Exit Reason is 01: Live Birth.	prenatal.numBirthedChildren
Home School	Indicates the school district the mother attends.	prenatal.homeSchool
Serving School	Indicates where the mother receives services.	prenatal.servingSchool
Mother's Education Received Required	Lists the mother's highest level of education.	prenatal.educationReceived
Mother's Employment Status Required	Lists the mother's current employment status.	prenatal.employmentStatus
Number of Doula Services Rec'd/Yr Required	Indicates the total number of the number of Doula Services received during the year, between 0 and 99.  A Doula is a person trained to assist a woman during childbirth and may provide support to the family after the baby is born.	N/A
Fiscal Year Required	Indicates in which fiscal year the mother received prenatal services.  ISBE's annual financial/accounting reporting period runs from July 1 to June 30th.	N/A
