


Discipline Incidents (Oregon)

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Tool Search: OR Incidents

The Discipline Incidents File collects information for all students who were removed during the selected school year. All removals resulting in In School Suspension, Out of School Suspension, Expulsion, or in an Interim Alternative Education Setting that start on or between July 1st to June 30th in the selected school year are expected to report.



This report might look different to some of the other available Oregon reports. Organizationwide initiatives are being made to address technology and accessibility improvements.



Report Logic

One record per qualifying removal where the removal start date falls on or between July 1 and June 30 of the reporting school year.

When the Behavior Resolution Start Date does NOT fall on or between July 1 and June 03, no record reports.

- All removals report in the school year in which the student's removal started.
 - Removals starting in a prior year and continuing into the current school year DO NOT report in the current school year.
 - Removal occurring after June 30th DOES NOT report in the current school year (e.g., they must report in the following school year's collection).


This report truncates reporting population and field calculations to report data only within the expected reporting school year dates.

To report, a student must have a Student State ID.

A student does NOT report when:

- The Calendar of Enrollment is marked as State Exclude.
- The Enrollment record is marked as State Exclude or No Show.
- The Grade Level of Enrollment is marked as State Exclude.

Behavior resolutions must be mapped to a State Resolution Code of ISS, OSS, EXP or IAES. Resolutions mapped to Truancy do not report. Resolutions not mapped to one of these four state resolution codes do not report.






Report Editor

Data Element	Description
Report Options	
Report Type	Determines which report generates - Discipline Incidents or Restraint and Seclusion Incidents.
Start Date	Entered date reflects the start of the reporting range in which data reports. This field defaults to July 01 of the school start year.
End Date	Entered date reflects the end of the reporting range in which data reports. This field defaults to June 30 of the school end year.
Ad hoc Filter	Select which students to include in the extract by choosing a filter that was created in the Filter Designer. Only those students included in the filter are included in the report.
Output Options	
Report Processing	To generate the report immediately, select Generate Now option. To choose when the report generates, use the Submit to Batch option. Submit to Batch is useful when generating the report for several calendars or for larger amounts of data being reported. See the Batch Queue article for more information.
Format Type	Determines in which format the report generates - CSV, HTML or XML.

Generate the Report

- 1. Select **Discipline Incidents** from the **Report Type** field.
- 2. Enter the correct **Start Date** and **End Date**.
- 3. Choose an **Ad hoc Filter** to return just the course and staff information included in the selected filter.
- 4. Select the desired **Report Processing** option of **Generate Now** or **Submit to Batch Queue**.
- 5. Select the desired **Format Type**.
- 6. Click **Generate**. The report displays in the selected format.

The following fields are unique to the Discipline Incidents File Report.

Data Element	Description	Location
SECC Primary Disability Code	Reports the student's 2-digit Primary Disability code selected ONLY when the student has a locked Special Education Plan on the Discipline Action Date. Otherwise, reports as 00. Numeric, 2 digits	Special Ed Documents > IEP > Enrollment Information > Primary Disability Enrollment.disability1
Discipline Action Date	Reports the date the disciplinary action was taken against the student as a result of the incident. This may or may not be the same as the Discipline Incident Date. Date field, 8 characters (MMDDYYYY)	Behavior Management > Resolution Details > Resolution Start Date BehaviorResolution.timeStamp

Discipline Action Type Code	Reports the Resolution State Code mapped to the Resolution Type. When it is mapped to a State Event Code, reports the value only when it does not match the Primary Offense Type Code value. Otherwise, reports a value of 0000. Discipline Modifier Code	Reports a value of 1 when the Modification Reason selected on the reported resolution is 1: Shortened Weapons Expulsion modified (in writing) to less than one year.	Behavior Management > Resolution Details > Modification Reason BehaviorResolution.modificationRason

Data Element	Description	Location
Discipline Days	Reports the Duration in School Days value rounded UP to the closed half day. Counts as .5 when the Duration is less than half a day. Course as 1 when the Duration is more than half a day. Resolutions that start in the current school year and end in the following school year MUST have an accurate total spanning both school years entered into the Duration in School Days field. When the Duration in School Days field is blank, the number of school days associated with the resolution is calculated from the Resolution Start Date/Time or June 30 of the school end year, whichever comes first. Only days marked as School Days are included. Non-school days are excluded. Partial Days are rounded to the nearest whole day. When the Start Date is the same as the End Date, reports a value of 1. Interim Educational Services Flag	Reports a value of Y only when the Interim Education Services checkbox is marked on the reporting Resolution. Otherwise, a value of N reports. Violent Criminal Offense Flag	Reports a value of Y only when the Criminal Offense Arrest checkbox is marked on the reporting Resolution. Otherwise, a value of N reports. Alphanumeric, 1 character (Y or N)	Behavior Management > Resolution Details > Criminal Offense Arrest BehaviorResolution.arrest
