Summary

This event entity represents an occurrence of an infraction ranging from a minor behavioral problem that disrupts the orderly functioning of a school or classroom (such as tardiness) to a criminal act that results in the involvement of a law enforcement official (such as robbery). A single event (e.g., a fight) is one incident regardless of how many perpetrators or victims are involved. Discipline incidents are events classified as warranting discipline action.

Object Triggering Logic

Action Business Rule(s)

Post

Reports a record when the Behavior Incident has at least one event with a behavior that is mapped to an Ed-Fi Code **AND** has at least one reportable student associated to it with the *O: Offender* role **AND** is the incident is marked as "Complete" **AND** the event has at least one resolution with a discipline that is mapped to an Ed-Fi Code **AND** both the Incident Date and the Resolution End Date overlap the student's enrollment.

- Behavior-related resources will only report if the associated student is:
 - Participating in Special Education (SPED):
 - Student has a locked IEP that overlaps the date(s) of the reported Behavior Event OR
 - Student has no locked IEPs **AND** has a Flag with a State Code of 999 (IEP) that overlaps the date(s) of the reported Behavior Event.
 - Located in a School that is identified as a 21 CCLC school:
 - The 21st CCLC checkbox is checked on the school's current School History record.
 - School History records that take effect in the future are **NOT** considered current.
 - Event is firearms-related:
 - The Behavior Event is mapped to an Ed-Fi Code value of:
 - Handguns
 - Rifles/shotguns
 - Multiple firearms
 - Other firearms
- Do not report a record if the any of the following exclusions are present:
 - o Enrollment State Exclude Must be for all student's associated with incident.
 - o Enrollment No Show Must be for all student's associated with incident.
 - o Enrollment Grade Exclude from State Reporting Must be for all student's associated with incident.
 - Calendar Exclude
 - School Exclude
 - O Role selected is not O: Offender.
 - O The Incident Date or Resolution End Date fall outside of all student's Enrollment dates associated with the incident.
 - We cannot report a Discipline Action record that is outside of the enrollment dates (Tier 2 error -52007).
 - We cannot send one discipline-related resource without sending the full chain of resources (Tier 2 error -52010).
- **IMPORTANT**: For a Discipline Incident to report in AZ, there must be a reportable event, student, and resolution. If any part is missing, a record will not be sent.

Delete /Post

A DELETE / POST will be performed if the data element being altered is part of the resource's natural key. A PUT will be performed otherwise.

- When the following information on the Incident is changed:
 - Status (Locked / Unlocked)

- When an incident's status is changed to a value that is not "Completed."
- When all associated students' enrollments are deleted.
- When the associated student is no longer identified as Special Education for the time period of the incident.
- When the associated school is no longer identified as a 21 CCLC school.
- When the associated event is no longer associated with a firearms-related code.
- When the incident is deleted.
- When the associated event is deleted.
- When the student's Role changes to a value that is not mapped to an Ed-Fi Code.
- When the resolution is deleted.
- When the Resolution Start Date is changed to NULL.
