<b>Award Code</b>	Identifies the State Seal awarded to the student upon graduation: 01 - NM Seal of Bilingualism/Biliteracy.
<b>Date Awarded</b>	The date the student was awarded the State Seal.

<b>Award Type</b>	<p>Identifies the type of State Seal awarded to the student upon graduation. Options include the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>APP</b> - Assessment and Alt Process Portfolio</li> <li>• <b>CA</b> - 4 units of Credit and Assessment</li> <li>• <b>CPP</b> - 4 units of Credit and App</li> <li>• <b>TLC</b> - Tribal Language Certification</li> </ul>
<b>Language</b>	<p>Identifies the language in which the State Seal was earned.
