Homeless records may NOT overlap. Be sure Start and End Dates do NOT overlap.

Primary Night Time Residence

Homeless Primary Nighttime Residence Type denotes the kind of impermanent housing, or lack of housing, where the homeless student stays at night. This value is a required field for homeless children and youth as individuals who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence.

Homeless Unaccompanied Youth states whether or not homeless children or youth are in physical

custody of a parent or legal guardian. This value is a required field for homeless children and youth as individuals who lack a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence.
