## Report Logic



Logic determines the report population as follows:

- Report a record for each Special Ed State Reporting record (Student Information > Special Ed > General > State Reporting) active in the calendar(s) selected on the extract editor.
  - Students must have at least one valid enrollment record in the calendar(s) selected on the extract editor.
- The report will exclude any records tied to the following:
  - Enrollment records where State Exclude = True
  - Enrollment records where No Show = True
  - Grade Levels marked as Exclude from state reporting
  - Records tied to Calendars marked as Exclude
  - Enrollment records where the Start Date is greater than the Effective Date entered on the extract editor.
- In order to report, students must have at least one active Special Ed State Reporting record in the calendar(s) selected on the extract editor.
  - Only report if one of the following is true:
    - Special Ed State Reporting End Date is greater than or equal to the calendar start date.
    - Special Ed State Reporting End Date is null.

- Only report if the Special Ed State Reporting State Date is less than or equal to the calendar end date.
- Only report if the Special Ed State Reporting Start Date is less than or equal to the Effective Date entered on the extract editor.

## Generating the Extract

1. Enter the **Effective Date**. Data as of this date will report.
2. Select which **State Grade Levels** will report data.
3. Select which **Calendars** will report data.
4. Select the report **Format**. For submission to the state, select the CSV (State Format).
5. To further narrow results, select an **Ad Hoc Filter** (optional).
6. Decide if you want to generate the report or send the report to the state:

<b>Generate Report</b>	Click the Generate Report button to immediately generate the report. The report will appear in a separate window in the designated format.
<b>Submit to Batch</b>	<p>Clicking the Submit to Batch button to send the extract to the Batch Queue List. <a href="#">Batch Queue</a> functionality provides the ability to schedule when the extract is generated and allows users to navigate away from the Special Education Report editor while the extract is being built. The Batch Queue List also lets users view and access historical Special Education Reports which were run through the Batch Queue tool.</p> 
<b>Send to State</b>	<p>Clicking the Send to State button will send the report data to the state system (Synergy). Reports sent to the state will appear in the Web Service Queue List where you can view its current status (Status), view all data sent to the state (View Submission), and review any errors returned from the state (View Result).</p>  <p>This functionality requires proper <a href="#">Web Service Account</a> and <a href="#">Web Service Configuration</a> setup.</p>

## Understanding the Special Education Report

Use the table below to better understand what each report column means and how it reports data.

<b>SpecialEdAlternateAssessment</b>	Indicates the student will be taking an alternate assessment for state assessment purposes.
