## Before moving to Transportation 2.0:

With the [Campus.2527 Release \(June 2025\)](#), a new Student Transportation tool was made available.



Once Transportation 2.0 has been enabled, **you cannot switch back to the previous version**. Existing transportation integrations will break, and transportation data will no longer appear in the interface (with the exception of student parking data and parking documents). Previous transportation data will only be available via Ad hoc reporting.
