

# Behavior Resolution Report


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Tool Search: Behavior Resolution Report

The Behavior Resolution Report lists students who have resolutions assigned. The report can be generated in one of two ways: the Summary option only lists the number of resolutions for each student, whereas the Detail option lists the details of each resolution. Sort options are also available to customize how information displays in the report.

[Behavior Event Types](#) are created in the Behavior Office Settings, and resolutions are assigned to participants in the [Management Tool](#) and the student [Behavior](#) tool.

# Report Editor Fields

The following table describes the options available for generating the Resolution Report and how those options will affect the generated report.

Field	Description
<b>Which students would you like to include in the report?</b>	Select students for inclusion in the report by choosing Grade Levels or an Ad hoc Filter. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>When selecting grade levels, report results are limited to students actively enrolled in the selected grade level.</li><li>When selecting an ad hoc filter, report results are limited to students included in the selected filter.</li></ul>
<b>Which calendars would you like to include in the report?</b>	At least one calendar needs to be selected in order for the report to generate. Choose calendars by the active year, by school name or by year.
<b>No Date Range Specified</b>	When this option is selected, all behavior resolutions assigned at any time during the school year are included in the report.
<b>Filter By Resolution Assign Date</b>	When this option is selected, only behavior resolutions assigned during the entered Date Range are included in the report.
<b>Filter By Resolution Start Date</b>	When this option is selected, only behavior resolutions starting on the entered Date Range are included in the report.
<b>Display Options</b>	These options appear based on the setting established in the <a href="#">Preferences</a> tool. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><b>Race/Ethnicity</b> - lists the race/ethnicity for each participant</li><li><b>GenderIdentity</b> - lists the gender of each participant as Male, Female or Other (non-Male, non-Female). Other Gender is only included when a state has chosen to include additional gender option(s).</li><li><b>Special Ed</b> - reports a Y or N based on whether the participant has an active and locked IEP at the time of the resolution.</li></ul>
<b>Resolution Types</b>	Filters the report results to only resolutions of the selected type (Award or Discipline). Or, select All to include both resolution types.

Field	Description
<b>Report Type</b>	Indicates whether a Summary Report generates (includes a list of students and the resolutions to their behavior incidents) or a Detail Report generates (includes the details of each resolution, student data, event and resolution types). <b>Note:</b> the Detail Report does NOT report the Resolution Comments.  See the images below for examples of each type.
<b>Sort Options</b>	Determines how the report information sorts: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Number of resolutions (descending) - Sorts students by resolution count, beginning with students who have the most resolutions.</li> <li>Student Name - Sorts students alphabetically by last name.</li> <li>Grade and Name - Sorts students first by grade level, then by last name.</li> <li>Grade and Number of Resolutions (descending) - Sorts students first by grade level, then by resolution count, beginning with students who have the most resolutions.</li> </ul>
<b>Report Format</b>	Indicates how the report generates - in PDF, CSV or DOCX formats.

## Generate the Behavior Resolution Report

1. Indicate which students should be included in the report by selecting **Grade** or **Ad hoc Filter**.
2. Select the **Calendar(s)** that should be included in the report.
3. Select a **Date Range Option**.
4. Select the desired **Display Options**.
5. Select which **Resolution Type(s)** should be included in the report.
6. Select the desired **Report Type**.
7. Select the desired **Sort Option**.
8. Select the desired **Report Format**.
9. Click the **Generate Report** button. The report generates in the selected format.

## Demerits Calculation

Scenario	Calculation
One behavior event, one resolution	Demerits report for the one behavior event.
One behavior event, more than one resolution	Demerits report for the one behavior event. The number of resolutions associated with the behavior event does not matter.
More than one behavior event where each event has demerits and each event has a resolution	Demerits report for each unique behavior event and accumulate for each unique behavior event.
More than one behavior event where one or more events have one or more demerits, and each event has a resolution	Demerits are added together for each unique behavior event and accumulate for each unique behavior event, whether the value is a positive value, a negative value or a zero.

<b>Scenario</b>	<b>Calculation</b>
More than one behavior event where one or more events have one or more demerits, and one or more have multiple behavior resolutions	Demerits are added for each unique behavior event and accumulate for the each unique behavior event whether the value is a positive value, a negative value or a zero. The demerits value does not vary based on the number of resolutions associated with an event.
