

# Immunization Rules (New Hampshire)

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Tool Search: Vaccine Setup

Health vaccines and their associated compliance listings are based on state guidelines. While Infinite Campus maintains standard guidelines for all states, districts can enter additional compliance information. The following information describes vaccine compliance rules defined by the New Hampshire Department of Health.

## General Compliance

- Vaccine doses administered less than or equal to 4 days before the minimum interval or age are considered valid.
- Doses administered 5 days before the minimum interval or age are not considered valid and must be repeated as age-appropriate.
- Vaccines given before 6 weeks of age are not considered valid, with the exception of Hepatitis B.
- Half doses or reduced doses of a vaccine are not considered valid.

## DTaP

Doses	Requirements
<b>10-year booster dose</b> <b><i>Non-compliant</i></b>	The student is considered non-compliant if the following conditions have been met: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• student has received 1 booster dose of the DTaP or DTP vaccine, and</li> <li>• the difference between the dose and the effective date is greater than 120 months with a 4 day tolerance.</li> </ul>

Doses	Requirements
<b>PreK 3 doses Compliant</b>	The student is considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• student is in state grade 13: Preschool,</li> <li>• student receives 3 doses of the DTaP or DTP vaccine,</li> <li>• the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 42 days with a 4 day tolerance,</li> <li>• the difference between the second dose and the previous dose is greater than 28 days with a 4 day tolerance,</li> <li>• the difference between the third dose and the previous dose is greater than 28 days with a 4 day tolerance, and</li> <li>• the difference between the third dose and the effective date is less than 5 months with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.</li> </ul>
<b>PreK 4 doses Compliant</b>	The student is considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• student is in state grade 13: Preschool,</li> <li>• student receives 4 doses of the DTaP or DTP vaccine,</li> <li>• the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 42 days with a 4 day tolerance,</li> <li>• the difference between the second dose and the previous dose is greater than 28 days with a 4 day tolerance,</li> <li>• the difference between the third dose and the previous dose is greater than 28 days with a 4 day tolerance, and</li> <li>• the difference between the fourth dose and the previous is greater than 6 months with a 4 day tolerance.</li> </ul>
<b>PreK Default Non-compliant</b>	The student is considered non-compliant if the following conditions have been met: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• student is in state grade 13: Preschool, and</li> <li>• has not received any doses of the DTaP or DTP vaccine.</li> </ul>
<b>age 7+, 3 dose series Compliant</b>	The student is considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• student is older than 84 months (7 years),</li> <li>• student receives 3 doses of the DTaP or DTP vaccine,</li> <li>• the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 42 days with a 4 day tolerance,</li> <li>• the difference between the second dose and the previous dose is greater than 28 days with a 4 day tolerance,</li> <li>• the difference between the third dose and the previous dose is greater than 6 months with a 4 day tolerance, and</li> <li>• the difference between the third dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 48 months with a 4 day tolerance.</li> </ul>

Doses	Requirements
<b>5 doses</b> <b><i>Compliant</i></b>	The student is considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• student receives 5 doses of the DTaP or DTP vaccine,</li> <li>• the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 42 days with a 4 day tolerance,</li> <li>• the difference between the second dose and the previous dose is greater than 28 days with a 4 day tolerance,</li> <li>• the difference between the third dose and the previous dose is greater than 28 days with a 4 day tolerance,</li> <li>• the difference between the fourth dose and the previous dose is greater than 6 months with a 4-day tolerance, and</li> <li>• the difference between the fifth and previous doses is greater than 6 months with a 4-day tolerance.</li> </ul>
<b>4 doses</b> <b><i>Compliant</i></b>	The student is considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• student receives 4 doses of the DTaP or DTP vaccine,</li> <li>• the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 42 days with a 4-day tolerance,</li> <li>• the difference between the second dose and the previous dose is greater than 28 days with a 4-day tolerance,</li> <li>• the difference between the third dose and the previous dose is greater than 28 days with a 4-day tolerance,</li> <li>• the difference between the fourth dose and the previous dose is greater than 6 months with a 4-day tolerance, and</li> <li>• the difference between the fourth dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 48 months with a 4-day tolerance.</li> </ul>
<b>Default</b> <b><i>Non-compliant</i></b>	N/A

## Tdap

- One dose is required for students ages 11 and older if more than 5 years have passed since they received the last dose of a vaccine containing tetanus. Students younger than 11 at the beginning of the year are required to have the dose at the start of the next year.
- Another dose of Tdap is required 10 years after the original dose was received.

<b>1 dose 0-1 months</b> <b><i>Compliant</i></b>	Students are considered compliant when: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The student is no older than 1 month old.</li> <li>• The student receives 1 dose of the Hepatitis B (Hep B) vaccine.</li> </ul>
<b>2 doses 2-3 months</b> <b><i>Compliant</i></b>	Students are considered compliant when: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The student is at least 2 months old but is no older than 3 months old.</li> <li>• The student receives 2 doses of the Hepatitis B (Hep B) vaccine.</li> <li>• The difference between the second and previous doses is greater than 28 days with a 4-day tolerance.</li> </ul>
<b>2 dose (1st to 3rd)</b> <b><i>In Progress</i></b>	Students are considered in progress when: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The student receives 2 doses of the Hepatitis B (Hep B) vaccine.</li> <li>• The difference between the first dose and the effective date is less than 112 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.</li> </ul>
<b>2 doses</b> <b><i>In Progress</i></b>	Students are considered in progress when: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The student receives 2 doses of the Hepatitis B (Hep B) vaccine.</li> <li>• The difference between the last dose and the effective date is less than 56 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.</li> </ul>
<b>1 dose</b> <b><i>In Progress</i></b>	Students are considered in progress when: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The student receives 1 dose of the Hepatitis B (Hep B) vaccine.</li> <li>• The difference between the last dose and the effective date is less than 28 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.</li> </ul>
<b>Default Non-compliant</b>	Students are considered non-compliant when they receive no doses of the Hepatitis B (Hep B) vaccine.

<b>PreK 1MMR Compliant</b>	The student is considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• student is in state grade 13: Preschool,</li> <li>• student receives 1 dose of the Measles-Mumps-Rubella-Varicella (MMRV) or Measles-Mumps-Rubella (MMR) vaccine, and</li> <li>• the difference between the dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4 day tolerance.</li> </ul>
<b>PreK 1M, 1M, 1R Compliant</b>	The student is considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• student is in state grade 13: Preschool,</li> <li>• student receives 1 dose of the Measles vaccine AND the difference between the dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4-day tolerance,</li> <li>• student receives 1 dose of the Mumps vaccine AND the difference between the dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4-day tolerance, and</li> <li>• student receives 1 dose of the Rubella vaccine, AND the difference between the dose and the student's birthdate is greater than 12 months with a 4-day tolerance.</li> </ul>

## Polio

Kindergarten students are required to have received the last two doses of polio vaccine separated by 6 months with the last dose given after age 4.
