Field	Description
State Seal and Certs	Indicates the type of state seal / certificate earned: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 00: World language proficiency certificate • 01: Gold bilingual or multilingual seal • 02: Platinum bilingual or multilingual seal
Date Earned	The month, day, and year the state seal / certificate was earned.
Language	The language associated with the earned state seal / certificate.
