### **Report Logic**

- The Student Restraint Event Interchange represents data for the restraints of all students that are administered by school district police officers and school resource officers working with an LEA under a local MOU and special education students who are restrained by LEA employees and volunteers.
- Students who meet the following criteria will NOT be included in the report:
  - Students with no State ID.
  - Students marked as State Exclude, are in a grade level marked State Exclude or enrolled in a calendar marked State Exclude.
  - Students with an ADA Eligibility = 0 or blank on all ADA records tied to the reporting enrollment.
  - Student restraint events that are performed by law enforcement personnel who are not employed by a LEA police department or who are not serving as an SRO under a MOU with an LEA.
