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Tool Search: OH Extracts

The Student Discipline (GD) extract reports all incidents in which a student receives a discipline action (i.e., expulsion, suspension, etc).

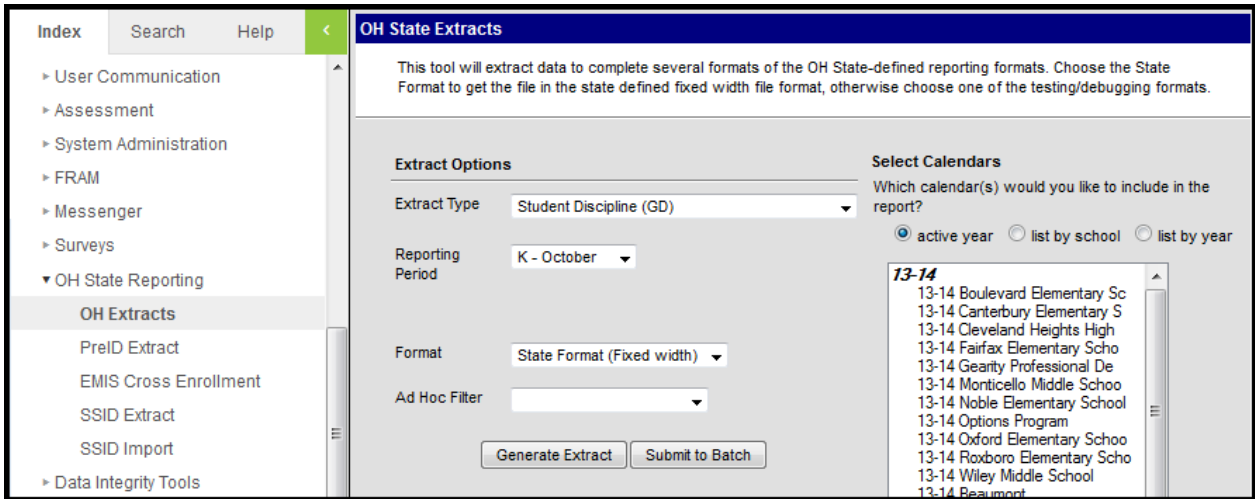


Image 1: Ohio Student Discipline (GD) Extract Editor

Reporting Population and Business Rules

#	Requirement
R1	Report a record for each individual incident for a student where the State Resolution Code is = 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, or 7.
R1.BR1	Do NOT report a record if DisciplineReason1 = '**' (Event code not tied to a State Code)

Generating the Extract

1. Select the Student Discipline (GD) **Extract Type**.
2. Select the proper **Reporting Period**.
3. Enter the **Date Range** in *mmdyy* format or by clicking the calendar icon and selecting a date. These fields will auto-populate with the recommended date range based on the **Reporting Period** selected.
4. Select the **Format**. For submission to the state, select the State Format (Fixed width). To review data prior to state submission, select any of the other available formats.
5. Select which **calendar(s)** to include within the extract.
6. Select an **Ad hoc Filter** to only report students included in the filter.

- Click **Generate Extract** to generate the report in the indicated format or **Submit to Batch** to schedule when the report will generate. If generating multiple extracts at a time (after Campus.1921), requests can only be submitted to the Batch Queue.

Users have the option of submitting an Ohio Student Discipline report request to the batch queue by clicking **Submit to Batch** instead of Generate Extract. This process will allow larger reports to generate in the background, without disrupting the use of Campus.
