Tool Search: Pre-Identification Extract

The Pre-ID Extract is used to identify students for testing purposes. This extract is populated with student demographic information that is sent to a testing company for the purpose of distributing tests amongst students. Any student with an enrollment record within the date range entered on the extract editor will report.

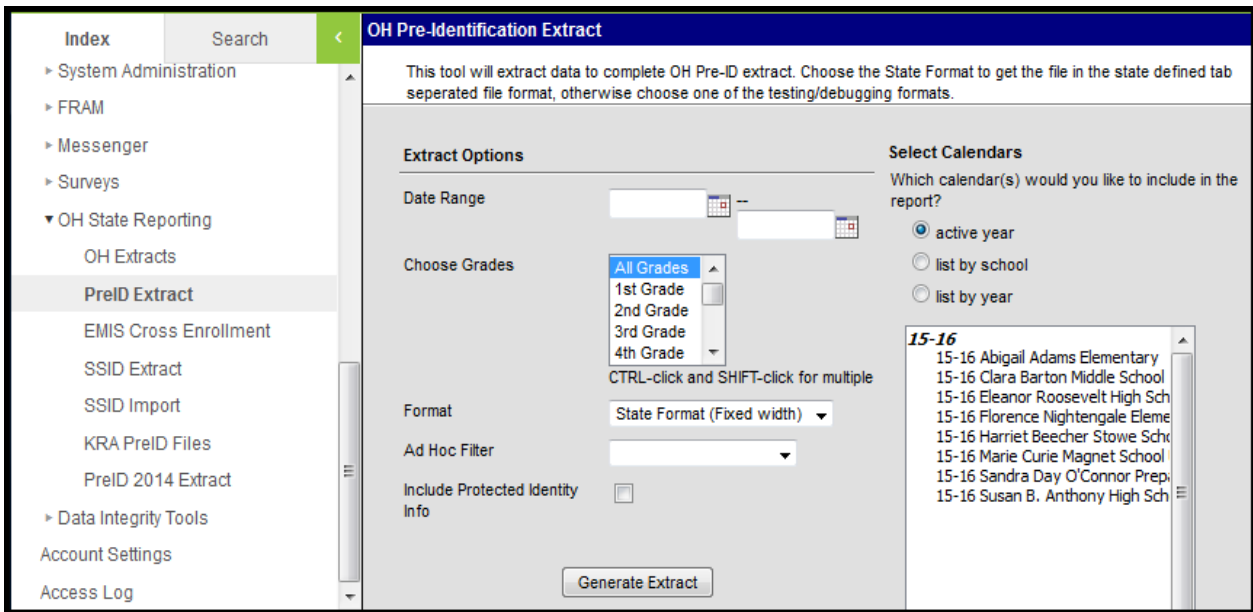


Image 1: Ohio PreID Extract Editor

Report Logic

If the student has an active enrollment between the start and end date on the extract editor, a record reports.

Generating the Extract

1. Enter the **Date Range** in *mmdyy* format or by clicking the calendar icon and selecting a date.
2. Select which calendar(s) to include within the extract.
3. Select which **Grades** to include in the extract from the calendar(s) selected.
4. Select the **Format**. For submission to the State, select the State Format (Fixed width). To review data prior to submission, select any of the other available formats.
5. Select an **Ad hoc Filter**, if applicable.
6. Indicate if the extract should **Include Protected Identity Info**.
7. Click the **Generate Extract** button. The extract will appear in a separate window in the designated format.

Extract Layout

If the **Include Protected Identity Info** checkbox is marked in the extract editor, Demographics fields report from Census > People > Identities > Active Identity > Protected Identity Information.
