These fields who have options managed in this way are:

Infinite Campus

- Role: The capacity in which someone participates in the meeting. Each participant can have one role. Examples: Counselor, Student, Advisor, Teacher.
- Location: Where the meetings takes place. A meeting can only have one location.
- Outcome: The result(s) of the meeting. A meeting can have multiple outcomes. Examples: Sent Letter Home, Referred to Social Services.
- Purpose: The reason(s) for the meeting. A meeting can have multiple purposes. Examples: Academic, Social, Post-Secondary Planning.
