## Tool Search: Test Setup

The creation of a test in Infinite Campus is referred to as a Test Structure that incorporates a single assessment. A test structure houses the attributes needed for test results. It controls how test elements will display on a student's [Assessment](#) tab.

One test can be structured as a hierarchy; that is, the "parent" test can contain many "child" tests to house test strands. Each parent/child level of the test can be configured individually, as desired.
