
Tool Search: English Learners

The English Learners (EL) tools allow users to manage student EL programs, assessments, services, and accommodations. It provides a central location for managing EL information, such as the date the student was identified as EL, when the student entered/exited an EL program, when the student is expected to leave an EL program, and First Year/Second Year Monitoring data.

For students who have exited and/or re-entered an EL program, a historical record is maintained and displayed, and can be viewed in both State and District Editions of Infinite Campus. The information provided below is specific to the state of **Texas**. Program Status Required	Indicates the student's EL status. Options include: • EL - Student is currently receiving EL services. • Exited EL - Student has exited the EL program. • Pending - Student has been identified as possibly needing EL services by the school, but no formal EL determination has been conducted. • Not EL - The student is not eligible/does not require an EL program. Identified Date	Date the student was identified as eligible for an EL program or service. This date reflects the date the student took the Screener/Initial Determination Test. This date is used to determine whether the student is participating in an English Language program.	<pre>Database Location: lep.identifiedDate Ad Hoc Inquiries: Student > Learner > EL > EL > programStatus</pre>
Expected Exit Date	Date the student is expected to exit the EL program.	Ad Hoc Inquiries: Student > Learner > EL > EL > expectedDate
Date Determined Misidentified	Indicates the date it was determined that the student was incorrectly identified as eligible for EL services.	Database Location: lep.determinedMisidentifiedDate Ad Hoc Inquiries: Student > Learner > EL > EL > determinedMisidentifiedDate
Program Exit Date	Date the student exited the EL program.	Database Location: lep.exitDate Ad Hoc Inquiries: Student > Learner > EL > EL > exitDate
Parent Notified	Date the student's parent(s) were notified about the student being eligible for EL services.	Database Location: lep.parentNotified Ad Hoc Inquiries: Student > Learner > EL > EL > parentNotified

Parent Declined Date	Date the student's parent(s) declined EL services.	Database Location: lep.parentDeclinedDate Ad Hoc Inquiries: Student > Learner > EL > EL > DeclinedDate
Comments	Any comments related to the student's EL record (500 character maximum).	Database Location: lep.comments Ad Hoc Inquiries: Student > Learner > EL > EL > comments
Home Primary Language	Displays the student's current Home Primary Language value. This field is read-only. This field is populated based on the values set in the Home Primary Language field, located on the ldentities tool. This value MUST be set in order to create an EL record.	Database Location: ident.homePrimaryLanguage Ad Hoc Inquiries: Student > Demographics > Identity History > homePrimaryLanguage
First Entered US School	Displays the date the student first entered a U.S. school. This field is read-only. This field populates based on the date entered in the First Entered US School field found on the Identities tool. This field is not required; however, users are highly encouraged to populate this field.	Database Location: ident.dateEnteredUSSchool Ad Hoc Inquiries: Student > Demographics > Identity History > dateEnteredUSSchool
Birth Country	Displays the country in which the student was born, populated on the <u>Identities</u> tool. This field is read-only.	Database Location: student.birthCountry Ad Hoc Inquiries: Student > Demographics > birthCountry
