


### **SIRS Programs Fact (New York)**

Tool Search: SIRS Extract

The SIRS Programs Fact Extract reports students who have program records designated through English Learners, Programs, Flags, FRAM, Homeless, or Graduation Seal areas of Campus.





#### **Report Logic**

The following date logic applies to all record types unless otherwise noted.

- To report, a program must have been active at some point during the reporting year.
- Program records are not included in the extract when the program's End Date is prior to their first Enrollment Start Date. Graduation Seal records are exempt from this logic.

#### **Enrollment Logic**

- First, the logic considers all Enrollments active on at least one date on or between the Calendar Start Date and the Effective Date on the extract editor per student.
- Then, only those Enrollments that are also active during the student's reportable program Start and End Dates are considered.
- When the student's program of record reports a Program Code reflecting a Disability Category, a record reports for the student.
  - This includes Program Codes of 5786, 0352, 0363, 0385, 0396, 0407, 0418, 0429, 0440, 0451, 0462, 0473, 0484 or 0495.
- When the student's program of record does NOT report a Program Code reflecting a Disability Category, and the following applies:
  - When only one Enrollment is active, and the Start Status is 5905, a record does not report for the student.
  - When more than one Enrollment is active, and all active Enrollments have a Start Status of 5905, a record does not report for the student.
  - When more than one Enrollment is active, and at least one Enrollment has a Start Status of 5905, a record reports for the student.

Records report when they meet the following logic. Some records report when they meet a specific set of conditions while others report when specific fields are filled, for example, on the EL Services tool or the Homeless Services tool. The numbers mentioned in the Logic column below report in the Program Codes element on the report.

Academic Programs (CTE)	Student records report when the Use Core CTE checkbox is marked on the extract editor. EL Services Records	Codes report from the EL Services tool when the <b>EL Service End Date</b> is null or within the reporting school year.

Flag Records	Student records must be associated with <u>Flags</u> that have the <b>State Reported</b> checkbox marked.



Record Type	Logic	
FRAM Records	To report, the student's FRAM Certified Type can NOT be Declined, Denied, or Did Not Apply AND was active during the current year on or before the Report Effective Date.  All eligible FRAM records within the current year report, including carryover records that started in the previous school year. FRAM records do not report when they begin AFTER the report Effective Date.  Students who have a FRAM record with an eligibility of Free (Program 5817) or Reduced (Program 5806) report FRAM records in the following manner:  • When there is more than one active record during the student's Enrollment dates in the current year, look for continuous records with the same Eligibility criteria and report the earliest start date in the Beginning Date field. Gaps between the older record's End Date and the newer record's Start Date are ignored when they have the same Eligibility criteria.  • Carryover records that begin in the previous school year have a Start Date of 07/01 for the current year. Continuous Eligibility Start Date would be the earliest Start Date or 07/01 when it is a carryover record.  • Continuous Eligibility End Date would be the End Date of the latest record that is on or before the Report Effective Date.  • Continuous Eligibility records report when the above is true, the eligibility values are not the same, and the records are active in the current year. Carryover records that began in the previous year have a start date of 07/01 for the current year. When there are multiple active records during the student's Enrollment dates in the current year, the report looks for continuous records with the same Eligibility criteria. It reports the earliest start date in the Beginning Date field. Gaps between the older record's End Date and the newer record's Start Date are ignored when looking for continuous records.  The Programs Code and the Beginning Date report from the State Seal Information when the Earned Date is greater than or equal to the Effective Date entered on the extract editor. Homeless Records	<b>8262</b> Homeless records report when the date logic is met on the Homeless tool.	
Homeless Services Records	When Homeless Services record meets the standard date logic, a Program Code reports from <u>Homeless Services</u> .

Program Records	Student records must be associated with <a href="Programs">Programs</a> that have the <b>State Reported</b> checkbox marked.	
	Programs with a code of 4026, 4027, 4037, or 4047 are excluded from the report population. These programs are reported on the <u>Partner Project Fact</u> extract.

Extract Type	The SIRS Extract to be run.	
<b>Effective Date</b>	The date for which information reports.	
Included State Grade Levels	Identifies the state grade levels to include in the report.	
Format	The Format in which the report should generate. Options are State Format (CSV) and HTML. Use State Format for reporting information to the state and the other types for data review and verification.	
Ad Hoc Filter	Selecting a filter limits the results to only those included in the filter.	
Column Headers	Indicates whether Column Headers should be included in the report. This dropdown list applies to State Format (CSV).	
Calculate 0198 Records	When this checkbox is marked, a 0198 Poverty record generates for each Free and Reduced Programs Fact record.	
Include Core CTE	When this checkbox is marked, each Academic Program Detail (Student Information) record that meets the reporting criteria reports.	
Generate Extract/ Submit to Batch	Users have the option of submitting a report request to the batch queue by clicking <b>Submit to Batch</b> instead of immediately generating the report by clicking <b>Generate Extract</b> . The batch process allows larger reports to generate in the background without disrupting the use of Campus. For more information about submitting a report to the batch queue, see the <u>Batch Queue</u> article.	
Select Calendars	Identifies which Calendar(s) should be included in the report. Calendars can be sorted by active year, by school or by year.
