

Code	Description	Definition
1	In the conservatorship of DFPS	Student is currently in the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services
2	PK previously in the conservatorship of DFPS	Pre-kindergarten student was previously in the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services
3	PK Student Foster at Any Time	Pre-kindergarten student is or ever has been in foster care in another state or territory, if the child resides in this state (Texas).
