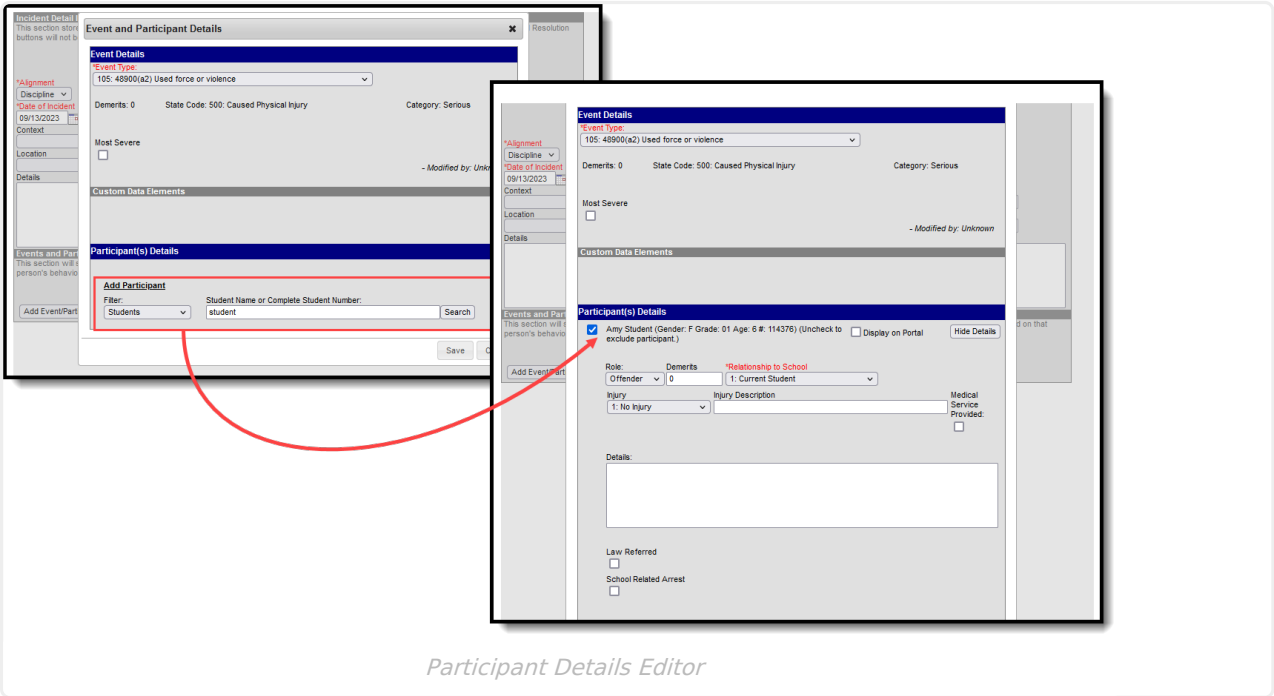

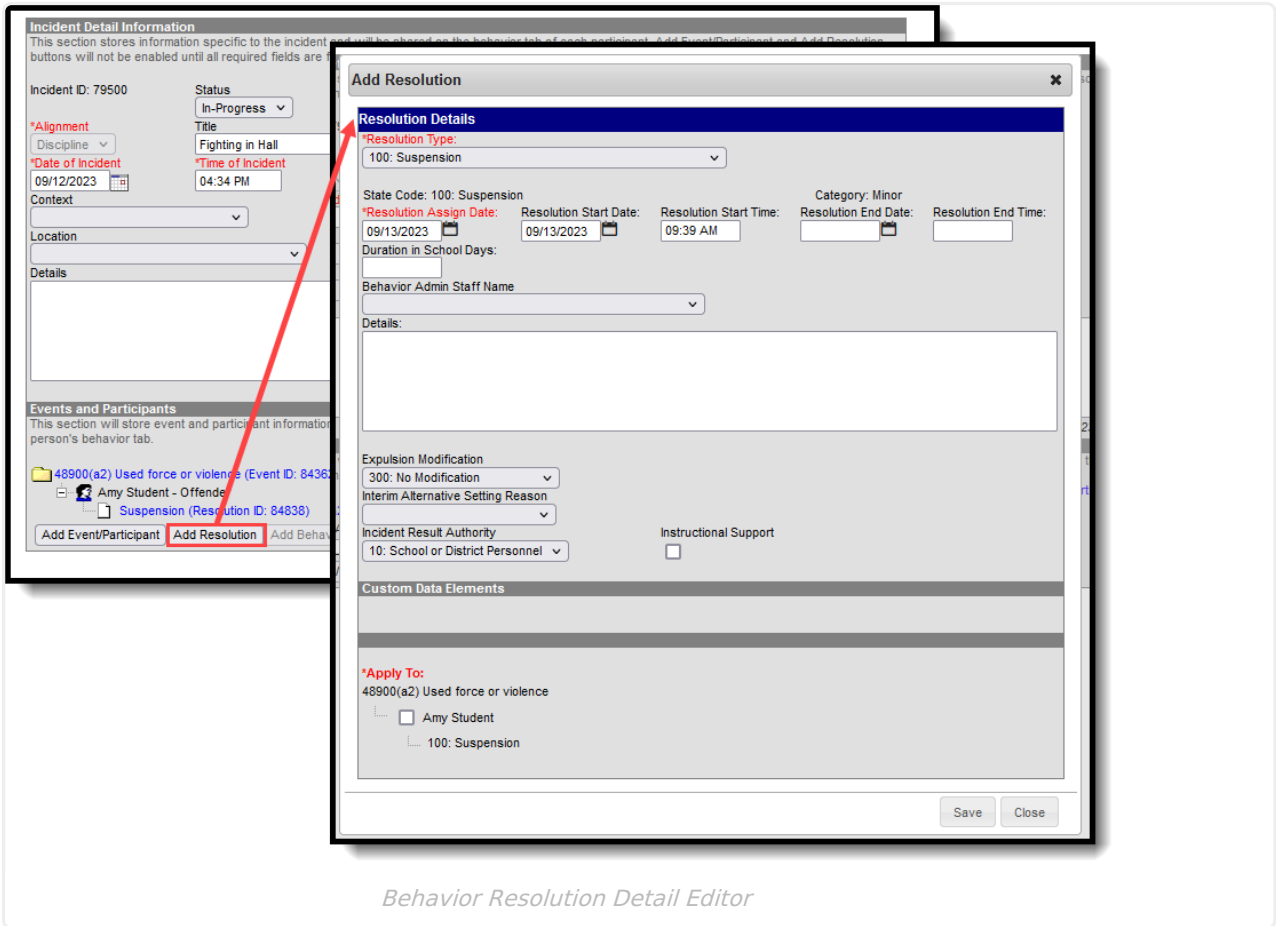
Weapon

Expulsion Modification

A coded value representing the Expulsion Modification Category. An Expulsion Modification Category is a category describing a modification made to an expulsion order, such as shortening the term of the expulsion.
