


# Extended Learning Opportunities (ELO) (Texas)

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Tool Search: ELO

An Extended Learning Opportunity (ELO) is a credit-bearing learning experience that takes place outside the traditional classroom. This tool allows users to add, edit, or delete ELO student records. Users may also print a summary of all ELO records for the selected student.

## Creating an ELO Record

Users can create ELO records for students by clicking **New**. Users may add as many ELO records as necessary for each student.

### Start Date

Indicates the date on which the ELO status began.

### End Date

Indicates the date on which the ELO ended.

If the End Date is left blank, state reports *assume* the ELO spanned the course of the current reporting enrollment (this could translate to multiple years of enrollments).

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## Program Type

The Program Type indicates the type of extended learning opportunity (ELO) program offered at the campus or the type of extended learning opportunity (ELO) participated in by the student. **This is a required field.**

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## Indicator

Indicates the total number of minutes the student was present and eligible for Foundation School Program funding during a particular reporting period. Eligibility for this program is determined by September 1 age and grade level.
