Health vaccines and their associated compliance listings are based on state guidelines. The following information describes vaccine compliance rules as defined by the Montana Department of Health.

General Compliance

- Half-doses or reduced doses of a vaccine are not considered valid.
- 4 day tolerance periods should be given for all spacing requirements.

DTaP

Note: DTaP rules track the initial series of the vaccine, while Tdap tracks the booster doses. Students must be compliant for both DTaP and Tdap.

Rule	Requirements
3 Doses - Complaint - Age 7 and older	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First does on or after 1 year of age • At least 1 dose of Td/Tdap on or after age 7
4 Doses - Compliant - Pre-Kindergarten	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be in a State Grade level of PK
4 Doses - Compliant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4th dose on or after age 4 • Difference between dose 4 and birth date is less than or equal to 7 years

Rule	Requirements
4 Doses - Compliant - Age 7 and older	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At least one dose of Td/Tdap on or after age 7

Tdap

Note: DTaP rules track the initial series of the vaccine, while Tdap tracks the booster doses. Students must be compliant for both DTaP and Tdap.

Rule	Requirements
PK to 6th <i>No Requirement</i>	Students in state grades: 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, KF, KH, P1, PK are not required to receive any doses of the Tdap vaccine.
1 dose grades 7-12 <i>Compliant</i>	Students are considered compliant if the following conditions have been met: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> the student is in state grade: 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, the student receives 1 dose of the Tdap vaccine, and the difference between the last dose and the student's birthdate is greater than or equal to 84 months with a 4 day tolerance.
Default	Non-compliant

MMR

Rule	Requirements
1 Dose - Compliant - Pre-Kindergarten	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> First dose on or after 12 months of age
2 Doses - Compliant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 2 Measles, Mumps and Rubella OR 2 Measles, 2 Mumps, 2 Rubella OR 1 Measles, Mumps, Rubella and 1 Measles, 1 Mumps, 1 Rubella 1st dose on or after 12 months of age Difference between dose 2 and previous is at least 1 month

Polio

No requirement for students 18 years of age and older.

Rule	Requirements
3 Doses - Compliant - Pre-Kindergarten	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No requirements
3 Doses - Compliant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dose 3 on or after 4th birthday Difference between dose 3 and previous is at least 28 days Difference between dose 2 and previous is at least 28 days

Hib

No requirement for students age 60 months and older.

No requirements for students in grades K-12.

Rule	Requirements
1 Dose - Compliant - Pre-Kindergarten	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1st dose on or after 12 months of age

Varicella

No requirement for students 0 to 11 months.

Default of non compliant.

Rule	Requirements
1 Dose - Compliant - Pre-Kindergarten	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Minimum age 12 months Dose on or after 1st birthday
2 Doses - Compliant - PK-12th Grade	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Minimum age 12 months First dose on or after 1st birthday Space between dose 1 and dose 2 must be equal to or greater than 28 days.
