The English Learner (EL) Extract reports all student EL records with a EL Program Status of 'EL' or 'Exited EL' within the selected calendar(s).




Image 1: Montana English Learner (EL) Extract

Use the State Format when all data has been reviewed for accuracy and information is ready to be uploaded. Use one of the other formats for data review and testing.






Image 2: Example of English Learner (EL) Extract - HTML Format

- 2. Select the desired **Format** from the dropdown list.

- 4. Click the **Generate Report** button. The extract will display in a new window in the selected format.
