General Compliance Rules

There is a 4 day grace period for deadlines of a dose. Doses administered 5 days earlier than the minimum interval will not be counted as valid doses and should be repeated as age appropriate.

Hepatitis B

3 doses Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade(s): KG, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, and • the student receives three doses of the Hepatitis B vaccine.

2 doses Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade(s): KG, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, and • the student receives two doses of the Hepatitis B - 2 dose vaccine.
Between doses 1-2 K-12 In Process	Students are considered in process when the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade(s): KG, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, • the student receives one dose of the Hepatitis B vaccine, and • the difference between the first dose and the effective date is less than 28 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.
Between doses 2-3 K-12 In Process	Students are considered in process when the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade(s): KG, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, • the student receives two doses of the Hepatitis B vaccine, and • the difference between the second dose and the effective date is less than 56 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.
Between doses 2-3 K-12 Test 2 In Process	Students are considered in process when the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade(s): KG, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, • the student receives two doses of the Hepatitis B vaccine, and • the difference between the first dose and the effective date is less than 112 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.
Between doses 1-2 Adult In Process	Students are considered in process when the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade(s): KG, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, • the student receives one dose of the Hepatitis B - 2 dose vaccine, and • the difference between the first dose and the effective date is less than 3 months with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.
Default K-12 Non-compliant	Students are considered non-compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade(s): KG, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, and • the student has not received any doses of the Hepatitis B vaccine.



Rule

2 mos No Requirement	Students 2 months old and younger are not required to receive any doses of the Hepatitis B vaccine.
3 mos Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 3 months, but no older than 4 months old, and • the student receives one dose of the Hepatitis B vaccine.
5 mos <i>Compliant</i>	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 5 months, but no older than 18 months old, and • the student receives two doses of the Hepatitis B vaccine.
19 mos Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 19 months old, and • the student receives three doses of the Hepatitis B vaccine.
Between doses 1-2 In Process	Students are considered in process when the following conditions have been met: • the student receives one dose of the Hepatitis B vaccine, and • the difference between the first dose and the effective date is less than 28 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.
Between doses 2-3 In Process	Students are considered in process when the following conditions have been met: • the student receives two doses of the Hepatitis B vaccine, and • the difference between the second dose and the effective date is less than 56 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.
Between doses 2-3 Test 2 In Process	Students are considered in process when the following conditions have been met: • the student receives two doses of the Hepatitis B vaccine, and • the difference between the second dose and the effective date is less than 112 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.



DTaP

Td, Tdap, DT, and DTaP vaccines are acceptable for these requirements.

5 doses Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade(s): KG, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, • the student receives five doses of the DTaP vaccine, and • the difference between the last dose and the student's birthdate is greater than or equal to 48 months with a 4 day tolerance.
4 doses Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade(s): KG, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, • the student receives four doses of the DTaP vaccine, and • the difference between the last dose and the student's birthdate is greater than or equal to 48 months with a 4 day tolerance.
3 doses Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade(s): KG, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, • the student receives three doses of the DTaP vaccine, • the difference between the last dose and the student's birthdate is greater than or equal to 48 months with a 4 day tolerance, and • the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than or equal to 12 months with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.
Grandfathered 6th- 12th Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade(s): 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, • the student receives three doses of the DTaP vaccine, • the difference between the last dose and the student's birthdate is greater than or equal to 46 months with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.

Between doses 2-3 at 7yr >= 12mo, K-12 In Process	Students are considered in process when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 84 months old, • the student is in state grade(s): KG, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, • the student receives two doses of the DTaP vaccine, • the difference between the second dose and the effective date is less than or equal to 5 months with a 1 day tolerance, and • the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is less than or equal to 12 months with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.

Between doses 3-4 at 7yr, K-12 In Process	Students are considered in process when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 84 months old, • the student is in state grade(s): KG, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, • the student receives three doses of the DTaP vaccine, • the difference between the third dose and the effective date is less than or equal to 5 months with a 1 day tolerance, and • the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is less than or equal to 11 months with a 4 day tolerance.
Between doses 4-5, K-12 In Process	Students are considered in process when the following conditions have been met: • the student is no older than 83 months old, • the student is in state grade(s): KG, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, • the student receives four doses of the DTaP vaccine, and • the difference between the fourth dose and the effective date is less than or equal to 5 months with a 1 day tolerance.
Default for K-12 Non-compliant	Students are considered non-compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade(s): KG, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, and • the student has not received any doses of the DTaP vaccine.
2 mos No Requirement	Students 2 months old and younger are not required to receive any doses of the DTaP vaccine.
3 mos Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 3 months, but no older than 4 months old, and • the student receives one dose of the DT or DTaP vaccine.



Rule	Requirement
5 mos Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 5 months, but no older than 6 months old, and • the student receives two doses of the DT or DTaP vaccine.
7 mos <i>Compliant</i>	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 7 months, but no older than 18 months old, and • the student receives three doses of the DT or DTaP vaccine.
19 mos Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 18 months old, and • the student receives four doses of the DT or DTaP vaccine.
Between doses 1-2 In Process	Students are considered in process when the following conditions have been met: • the student receives one dose of the DT or DTaP vaccine, and • the difference between the first dose and the effective date is less than or equal to 28 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.
Between doses 2-3 In Process	Students are considered in process when the following conditions have been met: • the student receives two dose of the DT or DTaP vaccine, and • the difference between the second dose and the effective date is less than or equal to 28 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.
Between doses 3-4 In Process	Students are considered in process when the following conditions have been met: • the student receives three dose of the DT or DTaP vaccine, and • the difference between the third dose and the effective date is less than or equal to 28 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.

Tdap

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Rule	Requirements
5 year Booster 7 Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student receives one dose of the DT, DTaP, TD, or Tdap vaccine, and • the difference between the last dose and the effective date is less than 59 months with a 1 day tolerance.
10 year Booster 8-12 Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade(s): 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, • the student receives one dose of the DT, DTaP, TD, or Tdap vaccine, and • the difference between the last dose and the effective date is less than 119 months with a 1 day tolerance.
1 Dose 7-12 Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade(s): 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, and • the student receives one dose of the Td, or Tdap vaccine.
Default 7-12 <i>Non-compliant</i>	Students are considered non-compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade(s): 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, and • the student has not received any doses of the Td, or Tdap vaccine.

Hib

Haemophilus influenza, type B (Hib)

Rule	Requirements
60 months and older No Requirements	Students 60 months old and older are not required to receive any doses of the Hib vaccine.
2 mos No Requirements	Students 2 months old and younger are not required to receive any doses of the Hib vaccine.
3 mos Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 3 months, but no older than 4 months old, and • the student receives one dose of the Hib vaccine.



Rule	Requirements
5 mos <i>Compliant</i>	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 5 months, but no older than 15 months old, and • the student receives two doses of the Hib vaccine.
16 mos Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 16 months, but no older than 18 months old, and • the student receives one dose of the Hib vaccine.
19 mos Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 19 months old, • the student receives one dose of the Hib vaccine, and • the difference between the last dose and the student's birthdate is greater than or equal to 12 months with a 4 day tolerance.
Between doses 1-2 In Process	Students are considered in process when the following conditions have been met: • the student receives one dose of the Hib vaccine, • the difference between the first dose and the effective date is less than 28 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance, and • the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is less than or equal to 11 months with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.
Between doses 1-2 12- 14mos In Process	Students are considered in process when the following conditions have been met: • the student receives one dose of the Hib vaccine, • the difference between the first dose and the effective date is less than 56 days with a 0 (zero) day tolerance, • the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than or equal to 12 months with a 0 (zero) day tolerance, and • the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is less than or equal to 14 months old with a 0 (zero) day tolerance.

2M, 2M, 2R Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade(s): KG, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, • the student receives two doses of the Measles vaccine, and • the difference between the second to last dose and the student's birthdate is greater than or equal to 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, OR • the student receives two doses of the Mumps vaccine, • the difference between the second to last dose and the student's birthdate is greater than or equal to 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, OR • the student receives two doses of the Rubella vaccine, and • the difference between the second to last dose and the student's birthdate is greater than or equal to 12 months with a 4 day tolerance.
1MMR, 1M, 1M, 1R Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is in state grade(s): KG, 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, • the student receives one dose of the MMR or MMRV vaccine, and • the student receives one dose of the Measles vaccine, and • the difference between the second to last dose and the student's birthdate is greater than or equal to 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, OR • the student receives one dose of the Mumps vaccine, • s OR • the student receives one dose of the Rubella vaccine, and • the difference between the second to last dose and the student's birthdate is greater than or equal to 12 months with a 4 day tolerance.

Before 16 mos No Requirements	Students 15 months old and younger are not required to receive any doses of the MMR or MMRV vaccine.
After 16 mos, 1MMR Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 16 months old, and • the student receives one dose of the MMR or MMRV vaccine.



Rule	Requirements
After 16 mos 1M,M,R Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 16 months old, and • the student receives one dose of the Measles vaccine, OR • the student receives one dose of the Mumps vaccine, OR • the student receives one dose of the Rubella vaccine.

Varicella

A note from a parent or doctor indicating that the student had the disease is acceptable in place of vaccinations.

19 mos Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 19 months old, • the student receives one dose of the Varicella or MMRV vaccine, and • the difference between the last dose and the student's birthdate is greater than or equal to 12 months with a 4 day tolerance.



Pneumococcal

PK and older No Requirements	Students 60 months old and older are not required to receive any doses of the Pneumococcal PPV or PCV vaccine.
before 2 mos No Requirements	Students 1 months old and younger are not required to receive any doses of the Pneumococcal PPV or PCV vaccine.
2 mos Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 2 months, but no older than 3 months old, and • the student receives one dose of the Pneumococcal PPV or PCV vaccine.
4 mos Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 4 months, but no older than 5 months old, and • the student receives two doses of the Pneumococcal PPV or PCV vaccine.
6 mos 3 shots Compliant	Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: • the student is at least 6 months, but no older than 11 months old, and • the student receives three doses of the Pneumococcal PPV or PCV vaccine.

12 mos 2 shots Compliant	 Students are considered compliant when the following conditions have been met: the student is at least 12 months, but no older than 23 months old, the student receives two doses of the Pneumococcal PPV or PCV vaccine, the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is greater than or equal to 12 months with a 4 day tolerance, and the difference between the first dose and the student's birthdate is less than or equal to 23 months with a 4 day tolerance.
