


General Assessment Test Structure

The **Test Setup** tool described below will be deprecated in a future release. The [Assessment Center](#) provides users with the ability to create and manage assessments administered to students for district, state, and national tests.

Tool Search: Test Setup

A General Assessment can be any test type (District, National or State) but the Assessment Type field should be set to Gen: General Assessment. The General Assessment type is most often assigned to a District test.

Create a General Assessment

 4. Select the other options for this new test as appropriate.
 5. Select the **Save** icon when finished.
