

RTI Interventions

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Tool Search: RTI Interventions

Interventions are set up to provide teachers and staff a set of predefined interventions they can select and use when setting up an RTI plan for a student. For example, a school has established an intervention for Behavior, Tier 2 requiring the student to use a Check In/Check Out attendance sheet.

Prerequisites

[RTI Plan Types](#) must be established (preferably for all Content Areas).

Create RTI Interventions

1. Select the **New** button. The Intervention Detail editor will appear on the right.
2. Enter the **Name** of the intervention.
3. Enter the **Content Area(s)**. This is important as it ties the intervention to plan types of this same Content Area. The intervention is only available for selection in RTI plans using a plan

type which has this same content type.

4. Enter the **Intervention Tier**.
5. Enter a Description of the intervention. This should describe the nature of the intervention and/or any instructions for the user when performing this intervention.
6. Enter a **Link** (if available). This should be a URL link to any materials or websites that should be accessed when performing this intervention.
7. Click the **Save** button. This intervention is now available for teachers and staff to select when [creating an RTI plan](#) for a student (see Image 2).




Image 2: Select an Intervention on an RTI Plan
