

Detention Scanner



The Scanning toolset is part of the [Campus Workflow Suite](#).

In order for scanners to work correctly, the cursor must be in the entry box prior to scanning a barcode. If the cursor is not in the box, the scanner will not be able to copy/paste the number into the box and the student will not be scanned in correctly.

Tool Search: Detention Scanner


The Detention Scanner tool is used to check students into a detention room. Students can scan ID cards and/or the teacher can manually enter Student ID numbers to take attendance.

The teacher then verifies the student is supposed to be in detention and then clicks **Confirm** or **Cancel**.
