



Tool Search: Custom Scanning Tools

Custom scanners created in System Administration are located in the Custom Scanning Tools module. These scanners can be used in two ways: a staff member attends the scanner, or the scanner runs as a kiosk. See [Custom Scanners](#) for additional information.



Depending on the settings made for your custom scanner, you will see varying screens and displays. See the [Custom Scanners](#) settings documentation for additional information.

Launch a Custom Scanner (Attended) without Additional Setup Selections

To launch the scanner, simply click on the appropriate scanner. The scanner opens for attended sign ins.

Once finished, press **Launch** to open the scanner.

Launch a Kiosk (Unattended/No Camera) with No Additional Setup Selections

NOTE: Once logged into the kiosk, the kiosk remains open unless the computer on which it's running has an inactivity logout time. For the kiosk to remain open, the computer itself must remain awake.

To launch a scanner as a Kiosk, the **Run as a Kiosk** option must be enabled in the scanner settings. See [Custom Scanners](#) for more information.

To launch the kiosk without additional setup selections, simply click on the appropriate kiosk.

Be aware that when launching the device as a kiosk, it opens in a new window. You are logged out of campus. The kiosk remains connected so students can scan in/out as needed.

- If you are logged in with a single sign-on account, you are required to sign out of your single sign-on account (using the **Sign Out of Single Sign On** button) before the kiosk can launch. Additional windows will pop up and automatically close as you sign out.

Selecting the **Launch Kiosk w/ Camera** option from the dropdown allows users to use the device's webcam to take a picture of the student's ID and use that to scan them in.







- If you are logged in with a single sign-on account, you are required to sign out of your single sign-on account (using the **Sign Out of Single Sign On** button) before the kiosk can launch. Additional windows will pop up and automatically close as you sign out.

If a student forgets to scan out of a custom scanning location and scans into a new location, the student is checked in to the new location but not checked out of the previous location.
