The Badge Designer tool allows users to create student and/or staff ID badges instead of using a third-party tool. Badges are printed using the [Badge Printing](#) tool.

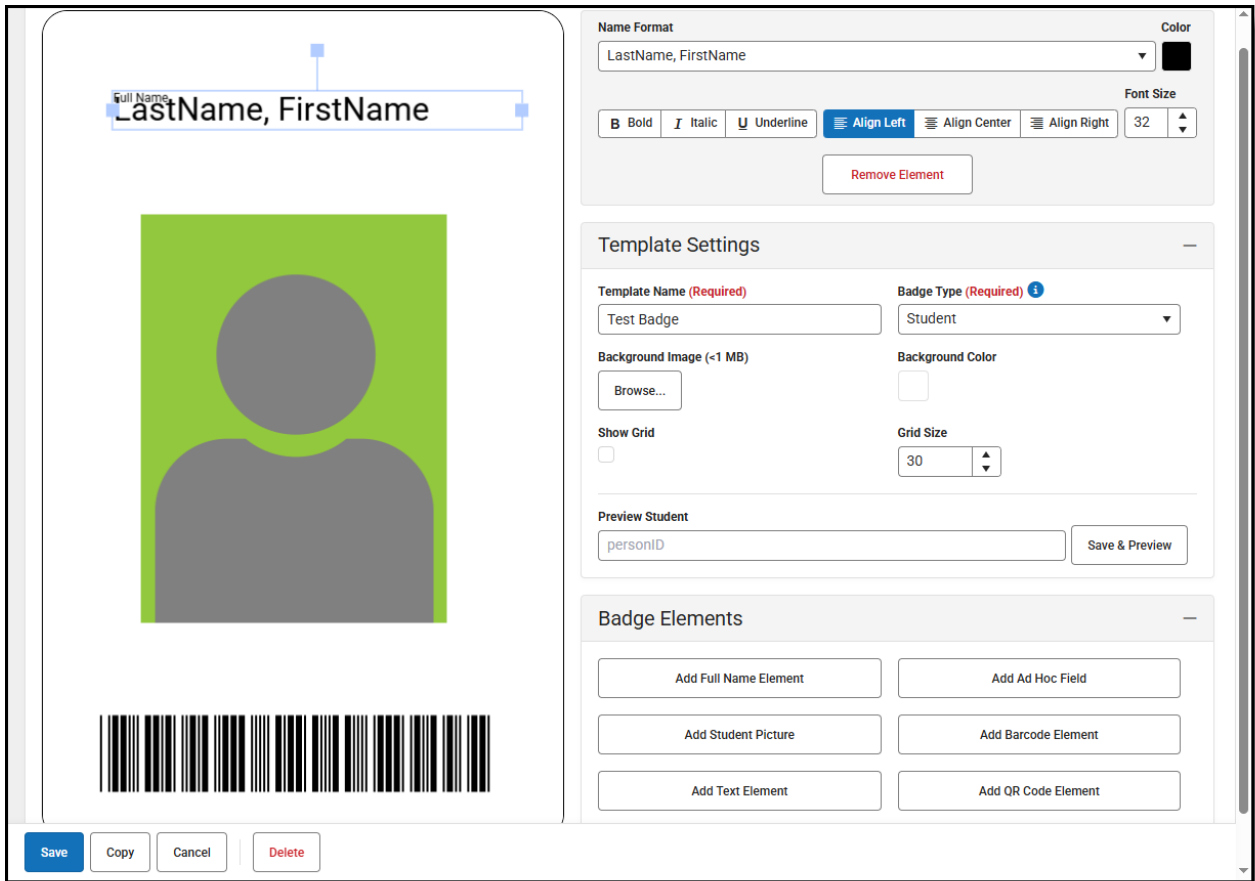

## Create a new badge

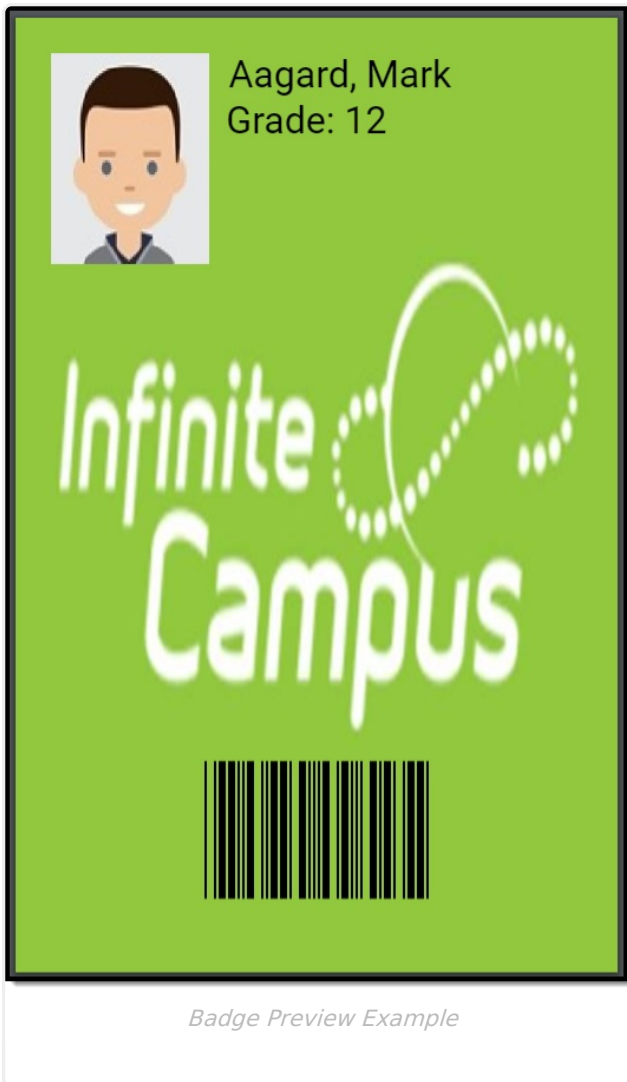
1. Use the **Template Name** field to enter a name for the template. This name is displayed in the Badge Printing tool.
2. From the **Badge Type** drop-list, select the type of badge to create: **Student** or **Staff**.
3. The **Background Image** allows users to upload an image to use on the badge.
  - Image size is 54mm by 86mm.
  - The aspect ratio should be 17:27 for an image to fit the badge.
4. Use the **Background Color** option to select the background color of the badge.
5. Mark the **Show Grid** option to add a grid while designing the badge. The grid is only visible during badge design and will not appear once the badge is printed. Elements can snap to the grid for ease of design.
6. To adjust the size of the grid, use the **Grid Size** options.

## Template settings

Field	Description
<b>Template Name</b>	The name of the template. This name is displayed in the Badge Printing tool.
<b>Badge Type</b>	The type of badge, either Student or Staff.  <b>Note:</b> Changing the badge type with existing ad hoc fields removes all existing fields on the badge.
<b>Background Image (&lt;2 MB)</b>	Adds a background image to the badge. The size of this image is 54mm by 86mm. For an image to fit, the aspect ratio should be 17:27.
<b>Background Color</b>	Adds a background color using a color picker or web hex.
<b>Show Grid</b>	Adds a grid to the badge only visible in this view. Elements can snap to the grid for ease of design.
<b>Grid Size</b>	Adjusts the size of the grid.

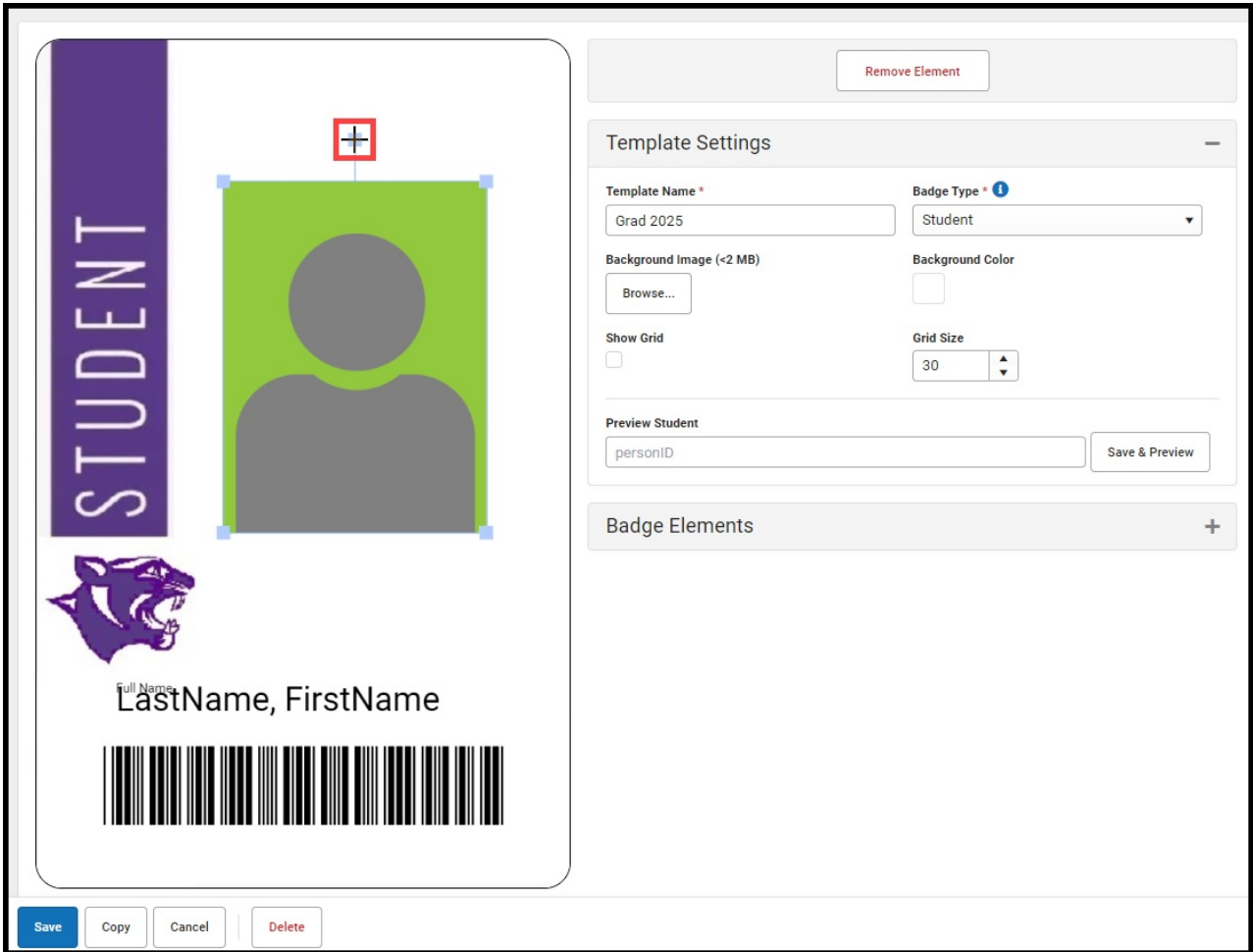
## Preview the student badge

The **Preview Student** function allows the user to view what the badge template will look like using a person ID number. The example badge is generated as a PDF.



## Badge Elements

Select an element within the Badge Preview to edit it. Elements can be moved by clicking and holding the element, then moving it to its new location. Elements can also be rotated by clicking and holding the square box above the element, then dragging it left or right until it has reached the desired position.



A section at the top of the Badge Designer Detail screen displays all edit options for the particular element. Click the **Remove Element** button to delete an element.

Element	Description
<b>Add Full Name Element</b>	Adds the person's name to the badge. This can be either Last Name, First Name or First Name Last Name.
<b>Add Ad Hoc Field</b>	Adds an ad hoc field that pulls all custom, student or staff fields. A Prefix can be entered before the ad hoc field to clarify what data is being pulled.  <div style="background-color: #e1f5fe; padding: 10px; border: 1px solid #cfcfcf;"> <p>In the example above, the student.grade ad hoc field is selected and the Prefix "Grade:" has been added. When previewing with a student, that field displays as "Grade: 12" instead of just 12.</p> </div>
<b>Add Student/Staff Picture</b>	Adds the person's picture to the badge.
<b>Add Barcode Element</b>	Adds a centered barcode, allowing you to choose what ad hoc field you wish to pull data from to generate the Barcode.

Element	Description
<b>Add Text Element</b>	Adds any text to the badge.
<b>Add QR Element</b>	Adds a QR code to the badge, allowing you to choose what ad hoc field you wish to pull data from to generate the QR Code.
