

OneRoster - Overview

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This article is intended for use by members of the Digital Learning Partner Program and is not designed for general Campus users.

OneRoster is a set of specifications established by the [IMS Global Learning Consortium](#). Campus created our OneRoster API based on these specifications.

The OneRoster API allows third-party vendors to share data with Campus by requesting section and student information and passing back assignments and scores. Two types of OneRoster connections are available:

- Rostering Services - Allows third-party vendors to receive section and roster data from Campus.
- Grade Book Services - Allows third-party vendors to receive section and roster data from Campus and push assignments and scores to Campus.

Digital Learning partners must be certified in the [IMS Global Specification](#) to connect to the OneRoster API. Upon entering the Partner Program, vendors receive a welcome packet with instructions for connecting to the API.
