This extract uses the following logic:



- Click here to expand...
  - To report, students must have an active enrollment in the selected calendar tied to a state grade of 03 12.
    - If the student has multiple enrollments, Campus uses the most recent primary enrollment.
    - If the student does not have a primary enrollment, the most recent enrollment reports.
  - This extract will return one record per student.
    - If the student has multiple assessments or transcript records that meet the criteria, report from Test Accommodations from Assessments that are active during the section dates.
    - If there are multiple assessments for a particular data elements group (ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies), report from the most recent Test Accommodations record for the group active during the section dates.
  - To report, students must meet one of the following requirements.

#### • ELA:
