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

01	Associate Degree	
02	Transferrable College Credits	
03	Professional Certification	A professional certification is any certificate or industry recognized credential in which the pupil prepared for by taking course work provided by a Michigan public or private college or university.
04	Michigan Early Middle College Association (MEMCA) Certificate	A five-year program of study that may begin as early as grade 9 and is designed to allow a pupil to earn a high school diploma while also earning 60 transferable college credits toward a four-year degree from a Michigan public or private university, an associate degree from a community college.
05	Registered Apprenticeship Program	Registered apprenticeships are high-quality work-based learning and post-secondary earn-and-learn models that meet national standards. Apprenticeship combines classroom studies with extensive on-the-job training under the supervision of journey level craft person or trade professional.
