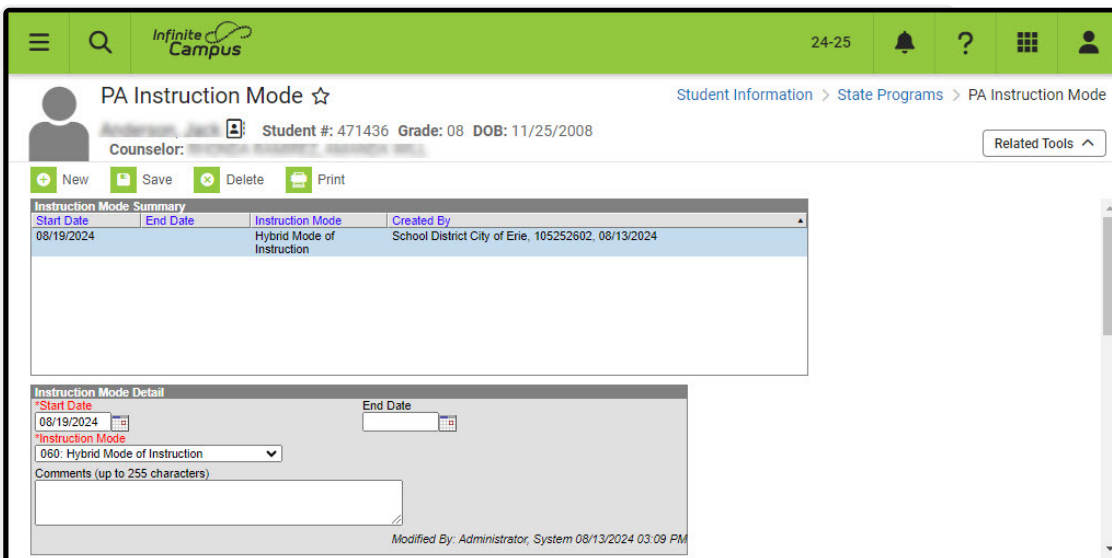
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## Tool Search: PA Instruction Mode

060	Hybrid Mode of Instruction	<p>Student is enrolled in a combination of face-to-face learning and remote learning as approved by the LEA’s governing body (e.g. Monday-Tuesday face to face, Wednesday-Friday remote, on a continuous basis.)</p> <p>This does not include Flexible Instruction Days (FID) or temporary periods that are necessitated by weather or illness, unless the period lasts for more than five consecutive days.</p> <p>Students who are enrolled in a virtual course that supplements LEA course offerings are not considered hybrid. Examples include, but are not limited to, advanced placement, dual enrollment, remedial, foreign language, elective, or other courses.</p>
061	Full Time Remote Mode of Instruction	<p>Student is enrolled in remote learning as approved by the LEA’s governing body for 100% of their instructional time for a period longer than five days. Remote education is on-line or distance education that replaces face-to-face course instruction, including synchronous or asynchronous delivery.</p> <p>This does not include Flexible Instruction Days (FID) or temporary periods that are necessitated by weather or illness, unless the period lasts for more than five consecutive days.</p> <p>Students who attend a brick-and-mortar building while receiving virtual or remote instruction for 100% of their education report as participating in full-time remote instruction.</p>
