The Graduation tool enables districts to track graduation information used in state reporting, AYP (Average Yearly Progress) determinations, and NCLB (No Child Left Behind) report cards. Districts can track when a student first entered ninth grade and calculate his/her expected graduation date.

01	Honors Diploma	Requires fulfillment of all requirements of either the Academic or Technical Honors designation. Consult the Indiana Department of Education website for more information.
02	ACT - College Ready benchmarks	Student must meet the following score requirements in at least two of the four areas: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A score of 18 on the ACT - English OR</li> <li>• A score of 22 on the ACT - Reading AND</li> <li>• A score of 22 on the ACT - Math OR</li> <li>• A score of 23 on the ACT - Science.</li> </ul>
03	SAT - College Ready benchmarks	Student must meet the following score requirements: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A score of 480 in Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (ERW) AND</li> <li>• A score of 530 in Math.</li> </ul>
04	ASVAB	The student must earn a minimum AFQT score to qualify for placement into one of the branches of the US Military. <p>The minimum score a student must earn is 31. 07	Career-Technical Education Concentrator	Student must earn a C average in at least two non-duplicative advanced courses (courses beyond an introductory course) within a particular program or program of student.
08	AP/IB/Dual Credit/Cambridge International Courses or CLEP Exam	<p>Student must earn a C average or higher in at least three courses.</p> <p>If a student is taking AP/IB/Dual Credit courses to meet the postsecondary-ready competency, either:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• One of the three courses must be in a core content area. Students pursuing liberal arts tracks must have at least one course corresponding with the Core Transfer Library (CTL). 09	Locally Created Pathway	<p>Student has met the requirements of an individualized program that has been adopted and approved by the SBOE, and demonstrates knowledge and skill for success after high school.</p> <p>It must have three criteria for approval - Collaboration, Competency and Continuous Improvement.</p>
10	Waiver from Postsecondary Readiness Competency	<p>To qualify for a waiver, the student has not been successful in completing competency requirements by the conclusion of their senior year. This includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A student who was in the process of completing a competency at one school that was not offered by the school to which the student transferred.</li> <li>• A student who has attempted to achieve at least three separate postsecondary-readiness competencies.</li> </ul>
11	Alternate Assessment for Alternate Diploma	Student has been identified through their Case Conference Committee as a student eligible to take the <i>I AM</i> assessment and receive an Alternate Diploma.
