

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Tool Search: Crisis Event

The Crisis Event tool tracks students who were enrolled, or are eligible for enrollment, but have temporarily or permanently enrolled in another school or district because of a crisis-related disruption in educational services.



Crisis Event Field Descriptions

The fields listed here may not be the fields available in your state.

Field	Description	Ad hoc Field Name	Database Location
Start Date	Indicates the date on which the crisis event began.	crisisEvent.startDate	CrisisEvent.startDate
End Date	Indicates the date on which the crisis event ended.	crisisEvent.endDate	CrisisEvent.endDate
Crisis Code	Indicates a state health or weather-related event that impacts a group of students, and may require additional funding, educational, or social services. These fields are state-specific.	crisisEvent.crisisType	CrisisEvent.crisisType

Field	Description	Ad hoc Field Name	Database Location
Crisis Name	Lists the crisis or disaster that led to the student being displaced.	crisisEvent.name	CrisisEvent.crisisName
Displaced Indicator	When marked, indicates the student was displaced by the event.	crisisEvent.displacedIndicator	CrisisEvent.displacedIndicator
Comments	Lists any applicable comments related to the crisis event record.	crisisEvent.comments	CrisisEvent.comments
