### DTap

Doses Needed	Age and Requirements
Preschool/Childcare	
No doses	0-1 month
1 dose	2-3 months
2 doses	4-5 months
3 doses	6-18 months
Kindergarten and Older	
4 doses	19 months and older
4 doses	Last dose on or after age 4

Doses Needed	Age and Requirements
4 doses	7 and older
3 doses	Td compliant with first dose after age 6

# Tdap

1 Dose is required for students 11 years and older if 5 years have past since the last dose of D/T containing vaccine.

## **Hepatitis B**

Doses Needed	Age
No doses	0-1 month
1 dose	2-3 months
2 doses	4-18 months
3 doses	19 months and older

#### MMR

Doses Needed	Age and Requirements
Preschool/Childcare	
No doses	0-15 months
1 dose	16 months and older (on or after 12 months of age)
Kindergarten and Older	
2 doses	On or after 12 months of age

## Varicella

Doses Needed	Age and Requirements
Preschool/Childcare	
No doses	0-15 months
1 dose	16 months and older (on or after 12 months of age)
Kindergarten and Older	
2 doses	On or after 12 months of age



## Polio

Doses Needed	Age and Requirements
Preschool/Childcare	
No doses	0-1 month
1 dose	2-3 months
2 doses	4-18 months
3 doses	19 months and older
Kindergarten and Older	
*4 doses	4-6 years
3 doses	Last dose on or after age 4
3 doses	7-18 years

#### Pneumococcal

Doses Needed	Age and Requirements
Preschool/Childcare	
No doses	0-1 month
1 dose	2-3 months
2 doses	4-5 months
3 doses	6-15 months
4 doses	16 months an older
1 dose	19 months - 4 years, on or after 24 months
No requirement	5 years and older

## HIB

Doses Needed	Age and Requirements
Preschool/Childcare	
No doses	0-1 month
1 dose	2-3 months
2 doses	4-15 months

Doses Needed	Age and Requirements
1 or 2 doses	<ul> <li>16 months - 4 years</li> <li>1 dose required if given on or after 15 months of age</li> <li>otherwise, 2 doses are required</li> </ul>
No requirement	5 years and older

## Meningococcal

One dose is required for Grades 6-12 or Ages 11-18.
