


# **Detentions by Event Type (Insights)**

Tool Search: Detentions by Event Type

Detentions by Event Type displays detention time assigned to students with an Early Warning Behavior GRAD score between 50 and 100 sorted by the event which led to a detention resolution.

This report is only available for users in districts who have purchased the Campus Analytics Suite.




You must also have calendar rights assigned for any calendar(s) reporting data.

## **Understanding the Chart**

The Detentions by Event Type displays detention time assigned to students (with an Early Warning Behavior GRAD score between 50-100) sorted by the event which led to a detention resolution for calendar selected in the Campus toolbar. Double-clicking a section of a bar will show you a table detailing all the data which makes up that colored section of the bar.




Use the table below for help in understanding each sub-report column:

Column	Description
Student Name	The name of the students who were the offender of the event type associated with the bar selected.
<b>Event Name</b>	The name of the behavior event.
<b>Event Role</b>	The role of the students for the behavior event.
Resolution Name	The behavior resolution assigned to the student for the behavior event.
Resolution Duration	The duration of the behavior resolution per student.
Resolution Duration Unit	The resolution duration unit assigned to the student for the behavior resolution.
Incident ID	A unique identifier assigned to each behavior event.



Column	Description
Student Person ID	The personID for the student assigned the behavior resolution.

Using the dropdown list shown in the image below, you can filter data to display the sum of detention hours, a count of behavior events per event type, or a count of students per event type.




<b>Chart Option</b>	Description
Sum of Detention Hours	This chart displays the sum of detention hours assigned to students per behavior event type.
<b>Count of Behavior</b>	This chart displays a count of events per behavior event type.
Count of Students	This chart displays a count of students per behavior even type

You can also remove and filter any data which makes up the chart by click the button selecting the type of data you wish to filter and unchecking data you wish to remove from the chart.

#### **Filtering Chart Data**


You can filter chart data to only students in your Early Warning Watchlist, in your Counseling Caseload, and/or a specific Student Ad Hoc filter by clicking the **Students** button and selecting any combination of these options. These options stack, allowing you to filter data as drilled down as only students on your watchlist who are also in your caseload and meet the selected ad hoc filter criteria (or any combination of these options).






# **Creating Templates**

Templates allow you to save all filtering and formatting options you have set for a chart and have these options automatically get applied each time you select the template. Templates are chart specific, meaning any templates created for a chart are only available and only apply to the chart it was created for.




For example, if you filter the chart data by Watchlist in the Student option (see section above) as well as modify any formatting and field options (any options shown below), all your selections can be saved as a template by clicking **Templates** and selecting **Save New Template**.





Once saved, each time you return to this chart you can automatically apply these options by clicking **Select Template**, choosing the template, and selecting **Apply**.



### **Additional Report Options**

The table below directs you towards additional information about all of the other on-screen options.



Option	Description
