The English Learners (EL) tools allow schools and districts to manage student EL programs, assessments, services, and accommodations. The EL tool provides a central location for managing EL information such as the date the student was identified as EL, when the student entered/exited an EL program, when the student is expected to leave an EL program and First Year/Second Year Monitoring data.

For students who exited and/or re-entered an EL program, an historical record is kept and displayed and can be viewed in both State and District Editions of Infinite Campus.


