

# Student Discipline Incident Behavior Associations (Texas v4.0)

This event entity represents an occurrence of an infraction ranging from a minor behavioral problem that disrupts the orderly functioning of a school or classroom (such as tardiness) to a criminal act that results in the involvement of a law enforcement official (such as robbery). A single event (e.g., a fight) is one incident regardless of how many perpetrators or victims are involved. Discipline incidents are events classified as warranting discipline action.

## Object Triggering Logic

Action	Trigger
Post	<p>Reports a behavior incident when the incident's Status is marked and saved as "Complete".</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Incident must have at least one behavior event associated.</li> <li>• Posting can occur if a new event is added after Incident is marked as "Complete".</li> <li>• Do not send if the student is in a calendar marked as Exclude.</li> <li>• Do not send if the student's enrollment is in a school marked as Exclude.</li> </ul>
Put	<p>When data that is not part of the Natural Key is changed.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If the student's role is changed.</li> </ul>
Delete/Post	<p>When the Incident's status is changed.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Delete when the status is changed from 'Completed' to 'In Progress'.</li> <li>• Post when the status is changed from 'In Progress' to 'Completed'.</li> </ul>
Delete	When an event is deleted.
Delete	When all non-excluded enrollments in the school and year are deleted.

## School Exclude, Calendar Exclude, Resource Toggle and Resync Logic

This table describes the School Exclude, Calendar Exclude, Resource Toggle and Resync logic of this object.

Action	Trigger
None	If a resource is toggled to 'OFF' after data has sent, all sent data will remain in the ODS but no new data will send.
Resync	If a record is in the Ed-Fi Identity Mapping table and not in the ODS, it will be deleted from the Ed-Fi Identity Mapping table.

Action	Trigger
Resync	If a record is in the ODS and it does not have a matching record in Campus or the Ed-Fi Identity Mapping table, it will be deleted from the ODS.
Resync	If a mapping is changed in Resource Preferences, a resync will need to be done to reflect the changes.

## Natural Key Changes, Cascading Updates, and Deletes Logic

This table describes the Natural Key Changes/Cascading Updates and Deletes logic of this object.

Action	Trigger
Post/Delete	Natural Key changes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If an Ed-Fi ID changes, this will happen with the cascading deletes from the Ed-Fi ID Change trigger.</li> </ul>
Delete/Post	If the Incident is deleted all dependent resources will delete.
Dependent Resources	Discipline Action <div style="background-color: #e1f5fe; padding: 10px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p>When a user deletes Student Discipline Incident Behavior Associations using the Delete Tool, the associated Discipline Actions are also deleted when Discipline Actions are auto selected because of the dependency.</p> <p>The user needs to resync the Discipline Actions after this type of delete.</p> </div>

## Scope Year Logic

Logic
Discipline records will only send to the school year that the incident date is aligned to. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Data will only send for the years that have valid configuration.</li> </ul>
