

Tool Search: SSID/USID/IUID Extracts

The Instructional Unit Identifier (IUID) collection provides an identifier for each class that a school/district offers, so data may be validated across the Staff Assignment and Class Roster data collections.

Each year districts submit a list of classes offered that includes the dates of the classes, the school in which it is offered and the course subject information to the Oregon Department of Education. The district receives an IUID number per class which is then uploaded into Campus using the IUID Import. The assigned IUID reports in the Staff Assignment and Class Roster collections.

**Consolidated Student ID (SSID) / Unique Staff Identifier (USID) / Instructional Unit Identifier (IUID) - Extracts**

**Consolidated Student ID (SSID) Extract:** This tool will extract a record for each student that does not have a Student State ID in the School Year selected on the Tool Bar. Choose the State Format to get the file in the state defined comma separated file format, otherwise choose one of the testing/debugging formats.

**Unique Staff Identifier (USID) Extract:** This tool will extract a record for each staff that has at least one active District Employment AND that does not have a Staff State ID in the School Year selected on the Tool Bar. Choose the State Format to get the file in the state defined comma separated file format, otherwise choose one of the testing/debugging formats.

**Instructional Unit Identifier (IUID) Extract:** This tool will extract a record for each active, instructional Section where Instructional Unit ID is blank on the Section Editor in the School Year selected on the Tool Bar. Choose the State Format to get the file in the state defined comma separated file format, otherwise choose one of the testing/debugging formats.

Instructional Unit Identifier (IUID) Extract

This is a two-fold process:

1. Generate the Instructional Unit Identifier extract to find the course sections that need IUIDs. This is then sent to the state.
2. Once the IUIDs have been assigned, use the [Instructional Unit Identifier Import](#) to assign the IUIDs to the course sections.

# Report Logic

One record per active/scheduled section reports where the Instruction Unit ID field on the [Section](#) editor is not populated or blank.

- The Course must be marked as active in order to report.
- The Section must be scheduled on at least one date during the school year, July 1 to June 30.

# Report Editor

Field	Description
<b>Extract</b>	Indicates which report is being generated.
<b>Format</b>	Indicates how the report generates. Options include CSV, XML, and HTML
<b>Apply All Excludes</b>	<p>When marked, students who are marked as one of the following are included in the report:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No Show or State Exclude on the Enrollment record</li><li>• Grade Level of enrollment is marked as State Exclude</li><li>• Calendar of enrollment is marked as State Exclude</li></ul> <p>When Exclude from State Reporting is marked on Course Information or Course Master Information, section of that course are included in the report.</p> <p>When NOT marked, any student or course marked as Exclude or No Show are NOT included in the report.</p>
<b>Report Generation</b>	To generate the report immediately, use the <b>Generate Extract</b> option. To choose when the report generates, use the <b>Submit to Batch</b> option. Submit to Batch is useful when generating the report for several calendars or for larger amounts of data being reported. See the <a href="#">Batch Queue</a> article for more information.

# Generate the Report

1. Select **Instructional Unit Identifier (IUID)** from the Extract dropdown list.
2. Select the desired **Format**.
3. Mark the **Apply All Excludes** checkbox to include enrollments, grade levels, courses and calendars that are marked as State Exclude in the report.
4. Click the **Generate Extract** button to display the results of the report immediately, or click the **Submit to Batch** button to choose when the report generates.

<b>Check Digit Instructional Identifier</b>	Lists a value of 10 zeros for each section where the Instructional Unit ID field is NOT populated.  <i>Numeric, 10 digits</i>	Section Information > Instructional Unit ID  Section.stateCode
<b>District Institution Identifier</b>	Reports the state-assigned District Number.  <i>Numeric, 10 digits</i>	District Information > State District Number  District.Number
<b>School Institution Identifier</b>	Reports the school number where the section is taught.  <i>Numeric, 10 digits</i>	District Information > State School Number  School.number
<b>Local Master Schedule Identifier</b>	Reports the Campus-generated Schedule ID of the selected Calendar Structure.  <i>Numeric, 10 digits</i>	Schedule Structure Setup > Structure ID  Calendar.structureID
<b>School Section Identifier</b>	Reports the Section ID of the section.  <i>Numeric, 10 digits</i>	Section Information > Section ID  Section.sectionID
<b>School Course Identifier</b>	Reports the Course ID.  <i>Numeric, 30 digits</i>	Course Information > Course ID  Course.courseID
