Object Triggering Logic

This table describes logic for triggering syncing of this object.

Action	Trigger
Post	<p>When a person has a District Employment record that overlaps the configured year and an active District Assignment record populated.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>When a person has a District Assignment record and the District Staff checkbox is not marked</p> <p>Does NOT report a record if any of the following scenarios are true:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. There is not an Ed-FI ID for the staff person. 2. The staff records are not active based on the Scope Year logic listed below. 3. When the record is triggered from a District Assignment record and it is marked as Exclude. 4. When the record is triggered from a District Assignment record and the School is marked as Exclude. 5. When data is sent prior to the Exclude checkboxes are marked, the data remains and the user needs to use the Delete Tool to remove data. 6. The Employment Status field is not mapped in Resource Preferences. <p>When the school staff member has more than one qualifying District Assignment record, a record generates for each eligible School/Start date.</p>
Delete/Post	<p>When any field part of the natural key changes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Start Date • Employment Status Descriptor <p>When there are two District Assignment records that create the same natural Key and one is deleted, the remaining record is posted.</p>
Delete	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When a District Employment record is deleted. • When a District Assignment record is deleted.

School Exclude, Calendar Exclude,

Resource Toggle and Resync Logic

This table describes the School Exclude, Calendar Exclude, Resource Toggle and Resync logic of this object.

Action	Trigger
None	When a resource is toggled to off after data has sent, all sent data remains in the ODS but no new data sends.
Resync	When a record is in the Ed-Fi Identity Mapping table and not in the ODS, it is deleted from the Ed-Fi Identity Mapping table.
Resync	When a record is in the ODS and it does not have a matching record in Campus or the Ed-Fi Identity Mapping table, it is deleted from the ODS.
Resync	When a mapping is changed in Resource Preferences, a resync needs to be done to reflect the changes.

Natural Key Changes, Cascading Updates, and Deletes Logic

This table describes the Natural Key Changes/Cascading Updates and Deletes logic of this object.

Action	Trigger
Delete/Post	Natural Key change: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> When the School Number/Ed-Fi School Number changes or the Ed-Fi ID changes, a delete/post occurs with the cascading deletes from the School ID/Ed-Fi ID Change triggers.
Delete/Post	When the Start Date or Employment Status Descriptor changes, the record deletes and reposts.
Delete/Post	There are no dependent resources.

Scope Year Logic

This table describes scope year logic of this object.

Logic
A record reports when a person has a District Assignment or District Employment record that is aligned to a scoped year. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reports when a staff has an active District Assignment or District Employment record that overlaps with the School year Start and End Dates. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> When School Year Start Date is NULL, 7/1/xxxx is the default start date used. When School Year End Date is NULL, 6/30/xxxx is the default end date used. Data only send for the years that have valid configuration.
Data only sends for the years that have valid configuration.
