

Tool Search: Early Learning

The Early Learning tool lists student information related to programs designed to improve the health, social-emotional and cognitive outcomes for all students from birth through third grade, using the federal guidelines.

Early Learning records cannot overlap, meaning only one active record for a student can exist at any time.

Early Learning Detail Fields

Field	Description	Location
Start Date Required	Indicates the date the student began Early Learning services.	Database Location: EarlyLearning.startDate Ad Hoc Inquiries: Student > Learner > Early Learning > startDate (earlyLearning.startDate)
End Date	Indicates the date the student stopped receiving Early Learning services.	Database Location: EarlyLearning.endDate Ad Hoc Inquiries: Student > Learner > Early Learning > endDate (earlyLearning.endDate)
Setting Required	Indicates the setting of the Early Learning program.	Database Location: EarlyLearning.setting Ad Hoc Inquiries: Student > Learner > Early Learning > earlyLearning.setting
Enrollment Type Required	Indicates the student's enrollment type. Multiple selections can be made for this field.	Database Location: EarlyLearning.enrollmentType Ad Hoc Inquiries: Student > Learner > Early Learning > enrollmentType (earlyLearning.enrollmentType)
Reason Exited	Reason for which the student ended the program.	Database Location: EarlyLearning.exitReason Ad Hoc Inquiries: Student > Learner > Early Learning > exitReason (earlyLearning.exitReason)
