5. Select the **Format** of the extract. Options are Comma Separated (CSV) or HTML.
6. Mark the **All Students** checkbox, if desired.
7. Select an **Ad hoc filter**, if desired.
8. Select the desired **Grades** to include.
9. Select the appropriate **Calendar(s)** from which to include data on the extract. This defaults

to the calendar selected in the Campus toolbar. At least one calendar is required.

10. Click the **Generate Extract** button or the **Submit to Batch** button. The extract generates in the selected format.
