


Cross-Site Enrollment Setup Tool Rights

Cross-Site Enrollment allows schools to manage situations such as tracking and reporting on students who attend courses offered by other schools, or allowing students from other schools to take classes they offer at their own school.

Staff such as Counselors, Curriculum Managers and Schedulers can use the Cross-Site Enrollment Setup tool to set up courses and sections to offer and map courses to other schools that offer Cross-Site courses.

Users MUST select a Year, School and Calendar (and Structure when applicable) to display information.

Schools must enable and configure Cross-Site Enrollment as outlined in the <u>Cross-Site</u> <u>Configuration</u> article. The user or users responsible for this configuration will need to be granted rights to these tools.
