

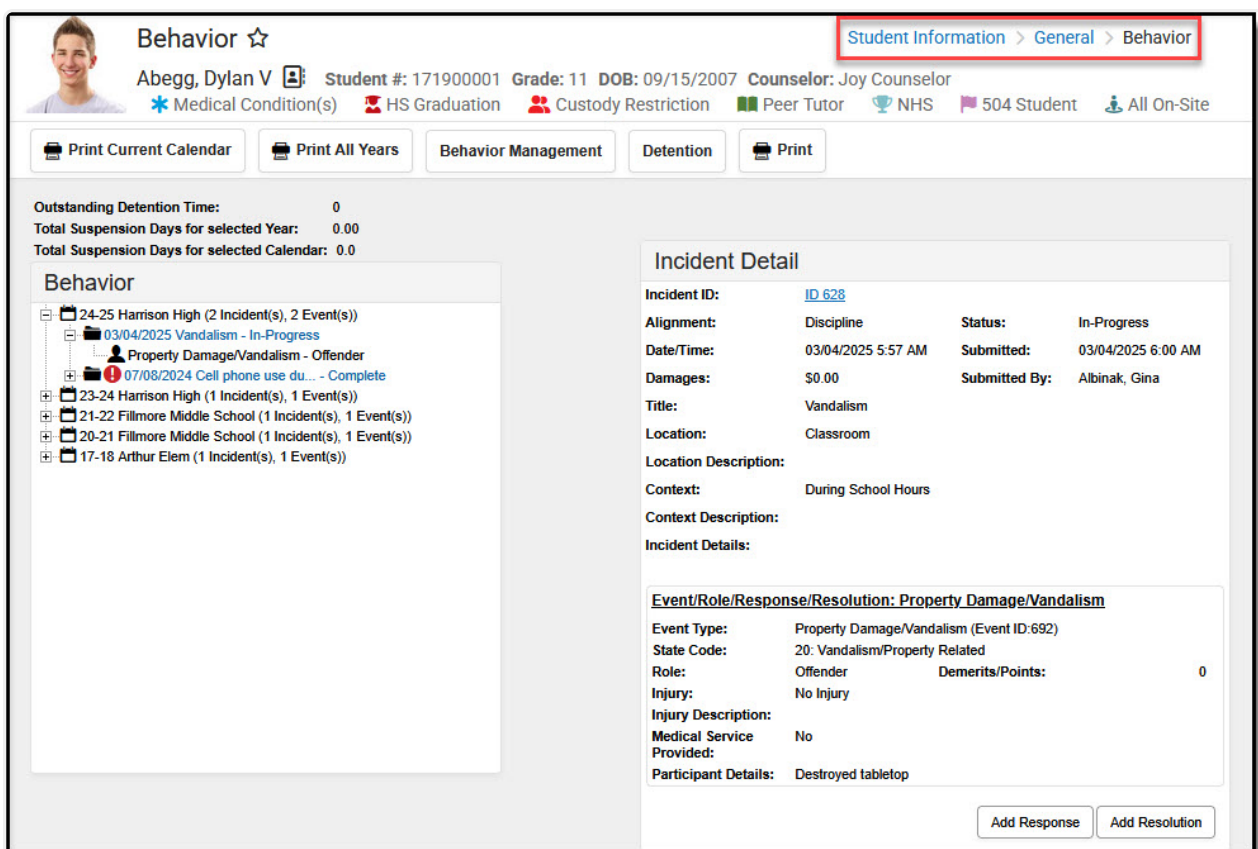
# Behavior (Student) Tool Rights

The **Behavior** tool lets staff such as Principals and Counselors see a history of the selected student's behavior events. Information about other students involved in a behavior incident with the selected student is not displayed.
