

Tool Search: Accelerated Instruction

Texas law requires all students who do not achieve "Approaches" or higher on STAAR grades 3 through 8 or EOC assessments to be provided accelerated instruction. The Accelerated Instruction tool allows districts to track a student's participation in an Accelerated Instruction program as defined by the state of Texas.



Read - View Accelerated Instruction records.


Write - Edit existing Accelerated Instruction records.

Add a Record

- 1. Click the **New** button. The Accelerated Instruction Detail editor displays.
- 2. Enter the applicable information for the student.
- 3. Click the **Save** icon when finished. The saved record displays in the Accelerated Instruction Summary.

Use the Federal/State Program Updater to import existing Accelerated Instruction records for students or to update records for multiple students.
