


# Grades Tool Rights

## Additional Tool Rights Information

Users cannot modify information on Student Grades. This tool displays In-Progress and Posted term scores based on information entered in the teacher's Grade Book.

Full access to Student Grades requires **R** rights to the following:

- Student Information > General > **Grades**
- Student Information > General > **Grades > Grade Book**: This subright turns the course name and grade grid into links that the user clicks to view more information about the grade and assignments that contribute to it.
- Student Information > General > **Grades > Additional Enrollment Grades**: This subright allows a user to print a report card for enrollments the student may have in other schools.

The following GPA tool rights are also available. Only **R**(ead) level rights apply.

- Term GPA**: Displays Term GPAs, including Weighted, Unweighted, and with and without Bonus Points.
- Rolling Cumulative GPA**: Displays Weighted Rolling Cumulative GPA, with and without Bonus Points.

- **Cumulative/Custom GPA** : Display any core and custom Cumulative GPAs, including Weighted, Unweighted, with and without Bonus Points, and any custom GPAs assigned to the calendar.
  - **Class Rank**: Displays the class rank associated with each cumulative GPA.
