


Student Constraints Roll Forward Wizard Tool Rights

The **Student Constraints Roll Forward Wizard** is copies placement restrictions between students (e.g. students who cannot be placed in the same course sections together) from one calendar to another.

Only Read rights are needed to grant full access to the Student Constraints Roll Forward Wizard.

Student Constraints Roll Forward

This tool copies the selected constraints to the selected destination calendar. The list of constraints is limited to those constraints eligible in the destination calendar. Note the following:

- Both constrained students must be enrolled in the destination calendar.
- The constraint cannot exist in the destination calendar.

Selecting an ad hoc filter may further limit the list of eligible constraints.
